

FREEDOM OF THE CHILDREN OF GOD

“Who through Him believe in God, who raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God. Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart.

Having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, because ‘All flesh is a grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls away, But the word of the Lord endures forever.’ Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.” 1Pet.1:21-25

We are the children of God if we received the Holy Spirit of God through our faith.

“That we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith”
Gal.3:14b

Without faith a child of God cannot please God or receive His Holy Spirit

“But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is the rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.” Heb.11:6

Law Vs. The Spirit

If a child of God does not have the Spirit of the living God he is under law, that law condemns the child of God to death. All those under the law are cursed into death.

“For as many as are of the works of law are under a curse.” Gal.3:10a

The greater the effort the child of God to justify himself, the greater the law bears down on him. The Holy Spirit cannot lead under law - finding the child of God in greater transgression of the law, producing works of the flesh manifesting his effort in darkness and death.

“What purpose then does the law serve? It was added because of transgressions.” Gal.3:19a

“Well then, why were the laws given? There were added after the promise was given, to show men how guilty they are of breaking God’s laws.”
Gal.3:19a Living Bible

“Because the law brings about wrath; for where there is no law there is no transgression” Rom.4:15

“Having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace.” Eph.2:15

The very thing sought by the child of God, that is, favor/freedom is lost in an attempt to please God through works of law, rather than the law given to Moses, or that of the land, or doctrinal laws of churches.

“I do not set aside the grace of God; for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain. Gal.2:21

“You have become estranged from Christ you who attempt to be justified by law, you have fallen from grace” Gal.5:3

Pleasing men, that is, making a pleasing appearance in the flesh by compromising of our faith puts the child of God under the law and cursed.

“For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ.” Gal.1:10

Loves Bond Vs. Laws Captivity

Christ bondservants are his body members, those who are baptized into the Christ as his body. Christ is now in a glorified spiritual body. What binds a body member into Christ as bondservants is the Spirit of Almighty God, Jehovah; not fleshly laws.

“Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of law, or by the hearing of faith?
Gal.3:5

“But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying Abba Father!” Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

Thus, there is not other good news for the child of God; no, none! But Jesus Christ and him alone impaled.

Preaching some thing other then Christ; including church doctrines; the child of God is accursed once again by the law that he has been set free from. Thus, brought under captivity.

Freedom vs. Doctrine

Freedom does not come through doctrine of men or woman even if they use scriptures. Freedom does not come through man at all. The source of real freedom is God’s Holy Spirit given to us through His Son Christ Jesus

“You were brought at a price; do not become slave of men”
1Cor.7:23

“But even if we, or an angel from heaven preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed.”Gal.1:9

The scriptures had not been completed at this writing there were many other oral teachings obeyed with equal force, but all had to have one good news, one truth, that is; Christ is our justification and we are set free through God Spirit all other teachings outside this foundation of Christ; are accursed and still under the law of flesh.

“I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel.

Which is not another, but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ.” Gal.1:6, 7.

“O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified? This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law or by the hearing of faith?

Are you so foolish? Having begun in the spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?” Gal.3:1-3

What a child of God receives is not from men or a group it comes down from the Father of lights it is a perfect gift uncorrupted by mans sin passed on through Adam.

“Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

Of His own will He brought us forth by the word of truth, that we might be a kind of first fruit of His creatures.”

James 1:16-17

Christ Vs. Doctrine of Religion

We are the most pitiful and deceived people on earth if a child of God believes that what is practiced in religion today is from God. Moreover, thinking God is condoning such conduct is a curse to the child of God.

“So that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us, for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, “For we are His offspring.”

“Therefore, since we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like gold or silver or stone, something shaped by art and man’s devising.

Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent.” Acts 17:27-30

Nor should the child of God deceive themselves that God Spirit rolls in the flesh and partakes of works of the flesh found in religions today!

“I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lust against the Spirit and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

Gifts of Spirit Vs. Works of Flesh

“But if you are led by Spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are; adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God” Gal.5:16-21

“Therefore, be imitators of God as dear children. And walk in love, as Christ also loved us and gave Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for sweet smelling aroma. But fornication and all uncleanness of covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as it is fitting for saints.” Eph.5:1

Flesh and Spirit are opposed to each other both produce fruits no child of God can be deceived by the fruits – they are darkness and light, sweet and bitter, thorns and lilies. –

Those under law, walking in the fleshly are in darkness existing in confusion about the fruits of God Spirit found in the child of God.

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.

“For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord, Walk as children of light for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth.

“And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them. For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. Manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light” Eph.5:8-13

“Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims abstain from fleshly lusts which are against the soul.” 1Pet.2:11

Spirit Vs. Worldly Wisdom

The flesh, those under law see the Spirit as weak and beggarly whereas the child of God walking in the Spirit see the flesh and its lust as a mortal enemy of spiritual life and darkness opposed to each other at war.

“But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.” 1Cor.2:14

Those lead by God Spirit discern the workings of the flesh and they are not deceived by the lust of the flesh or think its fruits as some thing sweet desirable feeding their souls.

“But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is rightly judged by no one.” 1Cor.2:15

Those under law walking in the flesh can master and control some of the works of the flesh in self-rightness.

Spirit Vs. Self-Rightness

However, the child of God can not through self-rightness control the works of the flesh. Strongly apprehending the lust of the flesh might seem godly to a fleshly person, but it does not justify the person before God nor does it obligate God to eternal life.

“These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, false humility, and neglect of the body, but of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.” Col.2:23

“So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His.”
Rom.8:8, 9

Spirit Vs. Self-Will

Christ is the Savior of his body, no child of God can boast in overcoming the works of his flesh through self-will. Self-will is opposed to being lead by God’s Spirit. It is the Holy Spirit working in and through the child of God that overcomes the world and conquers his fleshly mind.

“I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser, “Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away,” and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. “You are already clean because of the word which I spoke to you. “Abide in me, and I in you. As branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.” John 15:1-3

The child of God cannot clean himself from the flesh and its desires; he cannot produce spiritual fruits of God by works under law. Nor can he feed himself by searching the scripture daily supposing he will find life. No! He is totally dependent on the Savior of the body Christ Jesus and His Father to do the work within him; he is the spiritual temple of God without the use of unclean human hands.

Underserved Kindness Vs. False Humility

“Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in false humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, and not holding fast to the Head, from whom all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase that is from God.” Col.2:18

“For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. For we are *His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.*” Eph.2:8,9.

“For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and *He is the Savior of the body.*” Eph.5:23

Free Gift Vs. Boasting

A child of God cannot boast in a free gift. A gift given, although not deserved, but given due to His Sons Christ Jesus faithfulness. All things the child of God receives are from above through the Holy Spirit, including his faith and the fruits that grown through the vine his Head.

“For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as *God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.*”
Rom.12:3

“Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor. For we are God’s fellow workers; you are God’s field, you are God’s building.”
1Cor.3:8

“So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase.” 1Cor.3:7

God made the seed, God made the soil, God made the planter, God made the water, God made the Sun, God give us faith, and God gives the growth. Should not God receive the glory?

“But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God – *and righteousness and sanctification and redemption* – that, as it is written, “He who glories, let him glory in the Lord.” 1Cor.1:30

Christ Jesus Vs. Doctrinal Knowledge

We as God's children need to know but one thing and that one thing surpasses all worldly knowledge and wisdom offered through the fleshly mind.

“And I, brethren, when I came to you, did not come with excellence of speech or of wisdom declaring to you the testimony of God. For I determined not to know anything among you except Jesus Christ and Him crucified.” 1Cor.2:1, 2.

If the child of God wants greater wisdom than Jesus Christ, those needs are only satisfied through a fleshly mind not the spiritual mind of Christ Jesus the King of Eternity. The child has become a fool for the flesh, instead a fool for Christ. He loses his sanctification and puts himself outside the source of nourishment; bearing fruit of fleshly mind, making strong excretion that condemn him and those that listen to him.

“The purpose of our instruction, however, is love that rises out of a pure heart a clear conscience, and undisguised faith. Swerving away from this, some are turned off into empty talk, wanting to be law teachers without understanding what they say or about what they are making their strong assertions.” 1Tim.1:5, 6.

Holy Spirit Vs. a Bowl of Flesh

“Seek peace with all people, and the holiness without which no one can ever see the Lord. Be careful that there is not immoral person, or anyone worldly minded like Esau, who sold his birthright for one single meal. As you know, where he wanted to obtain the blessing afterwards, he was rejected and, though he pleaded for it with tears, he could find no way of reversing the decision.” Heb.12:14-17

When a child of God trades God's Holy Spirit for a bowl of flesh to teach law over God's undeserved kindness he loses his peace with God and finds himself in darkness wanting to obtain a blessing for his birth right reserved in heaven for him.

What a child of God gains by being a member in the body of Christ is not human or conceived of human thought.

Putting human organizations above the wisdom of Christ and His position creates a polluted Babylonish drunken stupor for the child of God. Mixing man teachings and God Spirit it is not possible, the foolish servant thinks it's is so, thus, leaving him without oil on the day of inspection by His master.

Made of God Vs. Man's Hands

“Inasmuch, as you saw that the stone was cut out of the *mountain without hands*, and it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold – the Great God has makes known to the king what will come to pass after this, The dream is certain, and its interpretation is sure.” Dan.2:45

“For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. He who believes in Him is not *condemned*; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the *condemnation*, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God.” John3:17-21

New Creation Vs. Law

“For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to live the light of the knowledge of glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.” 2Cor.4:6

“Can a fig tree, my brethren, bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh? James 3:12

Can you have both the law and Spirit, flesh and Spirit?

“No one puts a piece of unshrunk cloth onto an old cloak, because the patch pulls away from the cloak and the tear gets worse.

Nor do people put new wine into old wineskins; otherwise, the skins burst, the wine runs out, and the skins are lost. No; they put new wine in fresh skins and both are preserved.” Matt.9:17

God does not put His Holy Spirit into the old Law; He puts His Holy Spirit into a new creation inscribing His law of love in their hearts. He creates a new personality to conform to His Son’s Christ Jesus. He does not sew a piece of the new personality onto the old personality. He does not put Holy Spirit into the law so the spring issues half love and half death. In other words, life and death cannot be drunk at the same time.

“Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is *a new creation*; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.” 1Cor5:16, 17.

Spirit Vs. Earthly Demonic

“But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.” 1John 1:7

“But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. The wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, and demonic. For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.” James 3:14, 16.

Our Lord and Master is not a God of confusion and darkness when a child of God exists in a state of confusion and darkness there is fear, he is partaking of a spring issuing sweet and bitter water, the water of which is polluted.

The water is not good except in the fleshly deceived mind of the drinker. The child God cannot put a piece of flesh in pure water filled with Holy Spirit, the water will be polluted. Nor can a child of drink both and not lose his spiritual strengthen.

“For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the church of the saints.” 1Cor.14:33

Love Vs. Fear and Confusion

“Love has been perfected among us in this that we may have boldness in the Day of Judgment, because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. We love Him because He first loved us.” 1John 4:17-19

When a child of God accepts fleshly fruits as godly fruits; deceiving himself because the fruits are associated with a Christian organization. He is under fear, and torment, captive to law. He cannot find more freedom is eating greater amounts of doctrine.

Spirit Transformation Vs. Law Transformation

Subsequently, believing somehow, they are magically purifying fleshly works into sweet water Holy Spirit; he has become drunk and a fool for the flesh. Pleasing men is not the lot of the body of Christ. Christ knew what's in men and if we are members of that body we know what is in man as well.

“But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits without partiality and without hypocrisy. Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.” James 3:17,18

“That which is born of flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit”. John 3:6

“No one is good no one in all the world is innocent. No one has every followed God’s paths, or ever truly wanted to.” Rom.3:10-11

“Now we know that whatever the law says, is says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. Therefore by the deeds of the law no flesh we be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin.” Rom.3:19, 20.

“And why not say, “Let us do evil that good may come”? - as we are slanderously reported and as some affirm that we say. Their condemnation is just.” Rom3:8

Spirit Vs. Compromise of Faith

All children of God know that a war exist on earth between the flesh and the Spirit of God. Being held in high esteem by flesh is not the calling of God. Being loved by the world is not a war but a compromise of the faith.

If God’s Holy Spirit is in us, Satan knows and the child God cannot avoid the outcome. This should not seem strange or confusing to us such; persecution is the calling of the child of God.

“For it is written that Abraham had two sons; the one by a bondwoman, the other by a free woman. But he who was to the bondwoman was born according to the flesh, and he of the free woman through promise.” Gal.4:22

Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, a children of promise. But, as he who was born according to the flesh then persecuted him who was born according to the Spirit, even so it now.

Nevertheless what does the Scripture say? “Cast out the bondwoman and her son, for the son of the bondwoman shall not be heir with son of the freewoman.”

So then, brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman but of the free.” Gal.4:22, 28-31.

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall bruise your head. And you his heel.” Gen3:15

Spirit Judgments Vs. Religious Institutions Judgements

For a child of God to be confused when a religious organization persecute him, he, thus denies the truth he is call too and that’s in him. That is, the group or organization exist in the flesh and is worldly in manner. Allowing himself to be judged by men under law then accepting that judgment as from God is a compromise of the Spirit of the living God that anointed him as a son.

“Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free. And do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage.” Gal.5:1.

“But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes the deep things of God.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given us by God.

These things we also speak, not in words which man’s wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him: nor can he know them,

because they are spiritually discerned. For “who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?” but we have the mind of Christ.
1Cor2:10-14

Declared Righteous Vs. Self-Justification

“Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. Moreover it is required in stewards than one be found faithful. But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by a human court. In fact, I do not even judge myself.

For I know of nothing against myself, yet I am not justified by this; but He who judges me is the Lord.” 1Cor.4:1-4

The child of God has no judgment against himself, he is declared righteous not by men of flesh but by the God of Spirit. When he falls Jesus Christ feeds and cherishes the body part. God corrects the member in love through His Holy Spirit. Men of flesh cannot see this work, nor fully understand it; it is not natural, human or fleshly.

Thus, even self-condemnation does not work for the child of God it is of no value in the sight of God. God will correct and change the heart of the child of God. The child is bought and paid for by the blood of Christ and God alone takes credit for creating the new heart and spirit in His child of God.

Spirit Teaching Vs. Doctrinal Teaching

“No, this is the covenant I shall make with House of Israel when those days have come, Yahweh declares. Within them I shall plant my Law, writing it on their hearts. Then I shall be their God and they will be my people.

There will be no further need for everyone to teach neighbor or brother, saying, “Learn to know Yahweh!” No, they will all know me, from the least to greatest, Yahweh declares; since *I shall forgive their guilt and never more call their sin to mind.*” Jer.31:33, 34.

“There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. “ Rom.8:1

God’s Spirit Vs. Mans Condemnation

“Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself make intercession for us with groaning which cannot be uttered.

Now He who searches the hearts know what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God. And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Moreover, whom He predestined, these He also called: whom He called, these He also justified: and whom He justified, these He also glorified.” Rom.8:26-30

“For if our heart condemns us, God is greater, than our heart, and knows all things.” 1John 3:20

“Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. For in that He himself has suffered, being tempted. He is able to aid those who are tempted.” Heb.2:17

“Now this is the main point to the things we are saying; We have such a High Priest, who is seated at the right hand off the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle which the Lord erected, and not man.” Heb.8:1, 2.

“And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: “My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him. For whom the LORD loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives”? Heb.12:5, 6.

“Therefore, He has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens. You will say to me then, ‘Why does He still find fault? For who has resisted His will’? But indeed, O man, who are you to reply against God? Will the thing formed say to him who formed it? ‘*Why have you made me like this*’?” Rom.16-20

“Who shall bring a charge against God’s elect? It is God who justifies. Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us”. Rom.8:33, 34.

God’s Spirit Vs. Mans Organizations

For a child of God to deceive himself, thus, thinking an earthly organization is his mother or father that produces in him the Holy Spirit or that it will form him into a child of God; he has become a fool for the flesh and not Christ. To believe adhering to unscriptural doctrine will justify him before God; the God that gave His Son to justify his sins, is death - not life or freedom.

“But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angles, to the general assemble and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speak better things than that of Able. Heb.12:21-24

See that you do not refuse Him who speaks, for if they did not escape who refuse Him who spoke on earth, much more shall we not escape if we turn away from Him who speaks from Heaven.” Heb.12:

“Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ as though God were pleading through us; we implore you on Christ’s behalf, be reconciled to God.” 2Cor.5:20

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire. Heb. 12:25,28,29.

Heavenly Zion Vs. Earthly Organizations

Where the child of God believes more is needed then the Mount Zion the City of the Living God, that is, he needs edifices, doctors of theology, Reverends, spiritual men called fathers on earth.

He has a form of worship that's under law not grace or loving kindness. Furthermore, when the child of God believes God has an earthly organization a physical place of worship. He has taken the exalted superior reality, trading it off for earthly worship - a mundane inferior god.

“Jesus replied, “The time is coming, ma'am, when we will no longer be concerned about whether to worship the Father here or in Jerusalem. For it's now not where we worship that counts, but how we worship – is our worship spiritual and real? Do we have the Holy Spirit's help? For God is Spirit, and we must have his help to worship as we should. The Father wants this kind of worship from us.” John 4:21-24

God's Care Vs. Man's Care

“You have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and that your fruit should remain; that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name he may give it to you.” John 15:16

“But I will send you the Comforter – the Holy Spirit, the source of all truth. He will come to you from the Father and will tell you all about me.” John 15:26

“I have told you these things so that you won't be staggered by all that lies ahead. For you will be excommunicated from the synagogues; and indeed the time is coming when those who kill you will think they are doing God a service. This is because they have never known the Father or me.” John 16:1-3

God's Spirit Vs. Man's Appointments

For the child of God to believe that the Jews not having God's Spirit that is, (not being anointed), could appoint Christ Jesus as God's anointed messenger or judge Him correctly is foolish. To think those Jew's without God's Holy Spirit could shepard the Son of God under the control of God's Holy Spirit as his teachers is an apostasy.

“Jesus said, “for this judgment I have come into the world, so that the blind will see and those who see will become blind. John 10:39

Jesus answered them. “Truly, truly, I say to you, every one who commits sin is a slave to sin. The slave does not continue in the house forever; the son continues for ever: so if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed.” John 8:34

“ John answered and said; A man can receive nothing , except it be given him from heaven.” John 3:29

“ He that cometh from above is above all: he that is of the earth is earthly, and speaketh of the earth; he that cometh from heaven is above all.” John 3:33

“For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit.” John 3”34

For a child of God to be bewildered at fleshly men in religion, not anointed by God Spirit; believing they are able to make correct judgments about a child led by God Spirit - is equally as foolish.

Jesus Christ Vs. False Shepards

For the child of God to be in want of heart for fleshly elders to shepard him is a matter of attention not spiritual food. Such foolishness makes the child of God subject to law of the flesh that he cannot obey.

“If you love me, you will obey what I command. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever- the Holy Spirit of truth,

the world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor know him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.” John 14:15-18

“I am the Good Shepherd and know my own sheep. And they know me, just as my Father knows me and I know my Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep.” John 10: 14

“O fear the LORD. You his saints, for those who fear him have not want!

Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those of us who reverence the Lord will never lack any good thing” Ps.34:9, 10

“He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all – how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?” Rom.8:32

“Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or ask for a fish, will give him a snake?

If you, then, though you are evil, know how-to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!” Matt.7:

If men under law got good gifts from Jehovah God, how much more so a child of God who is not evil, but loved and declared righteous? However, if the child of God reverts back to law, thus, seeing his heavenly Father as a judge and Law giver; deciding for himself if he is worthy or, thus, determines what God will is according to a church or organization rules.

He is confused, under law and death; having a heart tossed about like of wave of the sea. Let not that man think he will receive anything from the Lord, he is indecisive in all his ways.

Holy Spirit Vs. Judgment of Fleshly Men

The child of God is called to judgments of fleshly men, that is, his walk in this life, but it is not of God or by God. It only serves the purpose of God, in judging the entire world through the body of Christ.

“The King will reply’ I tell you the truth, whatever you did to one of the least of these brothers of mine you did for me.”

Then he will say to those on his left, depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and the angels.

For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat. I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink. I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me. I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.” Matt.25:41-43

“I am sending you out as sheep among wolves. Be as wary as serpents and harmless as doves. But beware! For you will be arrested and tried, and whipped in synagogues. Yes, and you must stand trial before governors and kings for my sake. This will give you the opportunity to tell them about me, yes, to witness to the world.

Brother shall betray brother to death, and fathers shall betray their own children. And children shall rise against their parents and cause deaths. Everyone shall hate you because you belong to me. But all of you who endure to the end shall be saved.

The servant shares his master's! And since I am your master of the household has been called Satan, how much more so will you!

Don't imagine that I came to bring peace to earth! No, rather, a sword. I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law – a man's worst enemies will be right in his own home!

A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a servant above the master, it is enough for a servant to be like his master.” Matt. 10:34,35, 24,24.

“And you will need the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit – which is the Word of God. Eph.6:17

Holy Spirit Vs. Rulers of Earth

“Change your mind and attitude, or else I will come to you suddenly and fight against them with the sword of my mouth. Let everyone who can hear, listen to what the Spirit is saying to the churches.”

Rev.2:16,17a,

Can you hear? You can hear, provided you have God's Spirit.

Flesh can neither hear nor see. The Lord Jesus Christ is at the right-hand of God in immortal light and incorruption; a living Spirit Being.

The flesh is against the Spirit and at war with God and His anointed Son. No anointed son of God can stand in this fleshly world without God Holy Spirit; for he is not above his master; he is, but a part of the whole of his master. His master stood against this world not by his own will, but the will of the Father that was in him. God's will that sent him forth. Christ was led by his Father Holy Spirit, that is, if he let His Father will be done through him on earth as it had been in heaven.

Holy Spirit Vs. Rulers of Earth

The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against His anointed, saying, "Let us break their bonds in piece and cast away their cords from us."

The bond and cores of Christ body is the Holy Spirit of God; which the fleshly world hates. Nor should a son of God be fooled that a war does not exist and he can have a normal fleshly desires of this world life.

"For though we live in the world we are not carrying on a worldly war, for the weapons of our warfare are not worldly but have divine power to destroy strongholds. We destroy arguments and every proud obstacle to the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ, being ready to punish every disobedience, when your obedience is complete."

2Cor.10:3-6

"For we are not fighting against people made of flesh and blood, but against persons without bodies –

the evil rulers of the unseen world, those mighty satanic being and great evil princes of darkness who rule this world; and against –huge numbers of wicked spirits in the spirit world."

Eph.6:10-12.

Unity of Christ Body Vs. Doctrinal Seperation of Body

A child of God is not separate entity of the body of Christ. He does not have a different Spirit a different anointing then his head. He is not partially declared righteous. If his head died and was raised then the body parts are likewise raised. If the head is a Spirit then the children of God must be in the Spirit, part of that Spirit, and become completely that Spirit. If the head is justified before God; he (Christ Jesus) fulfilling the Law perfectly then the body has fulfilled the requirements of the Law perfectly.

And for this reason, (that is, a legal requirement of the Law) the child of God receives a gift of grace/underserved kindness because of the heads

perfect obedience too the Law. The Law being perfect condemns all humans perfectly too death.

No human could live under the Law perfectly, but Jesus Christ. So if you're a child of God, you have received a gift that surpasses all greatness to ever existed on earth, in our universe, and the spiritual heavens; see too it you do not beg off from such great glory.

If the Holy Spirit is hinder in a body part then the whole body suffers together. If there is a healing the whole body heals. If there is a sickness the whole body is ill. If there is faith in the head then the whole body is joined by that faith. If the head has gifts of Holy Spirit then the body has gifts of Holy Spirit. If the head in a spiritual war with demons, of course the body is at war with demons.

When a child of God is trick into believing that he is a separate part of the body, do to disfavor of a group, or do thinking more of himself then is necessary to think, or that he does not receive the fullness of the head; he is prey to the flesh and the demons.

Christ Position Vs. Man's Wisdom

All things are contained in the god head of Jesus Christ there is nothing lacking for his brothers; his body parts. Nothing! Everything for this life and the next life is contained in Jesus Christ the head of the congregation of God.

“Don’t let others spoil your faith and joy with their philosophies, their wrong ideas, instead of on what Christ has said. For in Christ there is all of God in human body; *so you have every thing when you have Christ, and you are filled with God through your union with Christ.* He is the highest Ruler, with authority over every other power.” Col.2:8,9

“He who loves his wife love himself. After all, no one ever hated his own body, but he feeds and cares for it, just as Christ does the Church - for we are members of his body. For this reason a man will leave

His father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.

This is a profound mystery – but I am talking about Christ and the church.” Eph.6:28b-32

“Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand the Lord’s will is. Do not get drunk with wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with Holy Spirit. Eph.5:17,18

The child of God understands this great mystery if he is bonded to his head through the Spirit of God. He understands the body must be healthy, but one way, and that is through the Holy Spirit, overcoming the works of the flesh in the child’s and all body parts.

Christ Headship Vs. Doctrinal Headship

Thus, child of God must leave the strong ties of mother and father cleaving to the head or lose God’s Holy Spirit. There can be no greater dishonor to a man than a wife taking his headship. Those walking in the flesh take away God’s Spirit, thus, taking Christ headship over them away.

“Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person – such a man is an idolater – has any inheritance in the kingdom

of Christ and of God. Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient."Eph.5:1,5,6.

Gifts of Christ Vs. Theology of Men

“Try always to be led along together by the Holy Spirit, and so be at peace with one another. We are all parts of one body, we have the same Spirit, and we have all been called to the same glorious future.

For us there is only one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and we all have the same God and Father who is over us all and in us all, and living through every part of us. However, Christ has give each of us special abilities – what ever he wants us to have out of his rich storehouse of gifts.

The Psalmist tells about this, for he says that when Christ returned triumphantly to heaven after his resurrection and victory over Satan, he gave generous gifts to men

But speaking truth in love may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ. From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto edifying of itself in love”

God's Spirit Vs. Power of Law

The child of God knows the power of law, he understand that all of creation under the rule of Satan has been formed through laws. Laws that govern the men's flesh. Laws of national groups, that war to uphold their national pride. Laws, of the land that punishes men's fleshly acts of disobedience. Laws that can build up the flesh to kill for honor and pride of country.

The power of law that has been fear inspiring to peoples of all national groups throughout the history of mankind on this earth.

The power of law, which forms huge companies and corporations; functions as powerful forces in our world. Rules, and laws of militaries that disciplines; break down the flesh, building the flesh into a fight force.

Yes, the flesh can, and is strengthen through rules of laws, that discipline the flesh. So it is nothing great whereas religions use proven methods of doctrine of men controlling their flocks - based upon the scriptures.

Nor should an anointed child of God be surprised when these religious groups have shunning shining success in growing numbers and controlling the flesh of their flocks through rules of laws and doctrines of men.

The success of fleshly law in the forming self piety and self-rightness, has been around since before Christ Jesus appearance on this earth as Son of God. These types of faiths have successfully controlled works of the flesh such as; adultery, fornication, drunkenness, fits of anger and so on. Many of these faiths are still practice in today's world with equal success.

“When the Gentiles who have not the law do by nature what the laws requires, they are a law to themselves, even though they do not have the law.” Rom.2:14

“Heaven can be entered only through the narrow gate! The highway to destruction is broad and it gates is wide enough for all multitudes who choose its easy way. But the Gateway to Life is small. And the road is narrow, and only few ever find it.” Matt.7:13, 14

However, the Spirit that Christ was led by, that is, the Holy Spirit of the Living God, breaks down the flesh and doctrine of men, and builds up the spirit of the child of God, into a new person.

“For all humanity is grass, and all its beauty like the wild flower's. As grass withers, the flower fades, but the Word of the Lord remains for ever.” 1Pet.1:24

“The grass withereth, the flower fadeth; because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it; surely the people is grass.” Isa.40:7

“But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat. The earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.” 2Pet.3:10

“But there are various kinds of materials that be used to build on that foundation. Some use gold and silver and jewels; and some build with sticks, and hay, or even straw! There is going to come a time of testing at Christ’s Judgment day to see what kind of material each builder has used.

Everyone’s work will be put through the fire so that all can see whether or not it keeps its value, and what was really accomplished. Then every workman who has built on the foundation with right material, and whose work still stands, will get his right pay.

But if the house he has built burns up, he will have a great loss. He himself will be saved, but like a man escaping through a wall of flames.

1Cor.4:12-15

The child of God know he was born of the New Jerusalem above its gates are made of precious stones and its streets are pure gold. They are not made of inferior works of the flesh, but by God’s Holy Spirit and the fruits of God’s Holy Spirit; tested in His son’s on earth by fire. None of which is made with human hands or an earthly organization.

The foundation of Christ is Holy Spirit precious there is not other Spiritual temple on earth God builds on, but the body of Christ. All works not built on this foundation of Christ Jesus the New Jerusalem above will be burnt up. Nor should a child of God be fooled through the fleshly mind that it is a group judgment of an organization. Christ Jesus judges each one according to their works. There will be no hiding behind doctrine of men to justify an earthly foundation under law and death.

Godly Training Vs. Power of Law

Routine and doctrine are powerful force in controlling and maintaining religious piety. The nature of the fleshly mind person is to judge according to prescribed routines that creates religious piety. Pressure through using these means show up weaknesses in the flesh; so it is nothing great wherein a person trained in religious doctrine and routine, can and does examine the flesh and make damning judgments of a person faith.

“Two men went to the Temple to pray. One was a proud, self-righteous Pharisee, and the other a cheating tax collector. The proud Pharisee prayed this prayer.

“Thank God, I am not a sinner like everyone else. Especially like that tax collector over there! For I never cheat, I don’t commit adultery, I go without food twice a week, and I give to God a tenth of everything I earn.

But the corrupt tax collector stood at a distance and dare not even lift his eyes to heaven as he prayed, but beat upon his chest in sorrow, exclaiming , ‘God, be merciful to me, a sinner.’ I tell you, this sinner, not the Pharisee, returned home forgiven! For the proud shall be humbled, but the humble shall be honored.” Matt.18:10-13

The child of God can start in Spirit and end up in the flesh through self-rightness. The law is powerful and pleasing to fleshly of eyes of self-righteous. Teachers of law want its power; adulation, pleasing men, and to control of the lives of their students.

The Spirit in the child of God is set free from the corruptions of the fleshly mind. But the power of flesh and institutional piety appears strong, whereas, the Spirit seems weak without bars or doors, it is despised and hated to the proud of heart.

“Jesus answered them, ‘Destroy this temple, and I will raise it again in three days.’

The Jews replied, ‘It has taken forty-six-years to build this temple, and you are going to raise it in three days?’ But the temple he had spoken of was his body.” John 2:19,20

Love Vs. Power of Knowledge

Where love is not taught, and knowledge is elevated to a god status; the child of God may be deceived into killing the freedom he has in Christ for a fleshly mind puffed up with knowledge of doctrine that pleases men. Thus, trading the very glory of Christ Jesus, and his headship for corruption, and death.

The super fine teachers of law are always learning, but are unable to come to an accurate knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

“If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.

And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give away all I have, and if I deliver my body to be burned, but have not love, I gain nothing.” 1`Cor.13:1-3

For the lover of knowledge, that is, super fine teachers of law: love on this list is rates last or not at all!

For the child of God led by the Holy Spirit of the Almighty God, love is his top priority, without love he is nothing at all; he is in death. He has lost the love of God to him; Christ Jesus and his headship.

God’s Forgiveness Vs. Guilt of Law

The power of law in the hands of self-righteous teachers steals what our Lord gave us freely, forgiveness of our sin. Guilt is the strongest fruit of the law of vine. The roots to which sinks deep into the fleshly mind.

Feeding the law into the vine and its branches, through religious doctrines of men. Producing the fruit of guilt; controlling the sheep. Teachers of this vine bring the child of God under control by guilt of law. The very Law Christ abolished in his death.

‘They brought to the Pharisees the man who had been blind. It has been a Sabbath day when Jesus made the paste and opened the man’s eyes, so when the Pharisees asked him how he had gained his sight, he said. ‘He put a paste on my eyes, and I washed, and I can see.’ Then some of the Pharisees said, ‘that man cannot be from God: he does not keep the Sabbath. Other said, ‘How can a sinner produce signs like this?’

“So the Jews sent for the man again and said to him, ‘Give glory to God! We are satisfied that this man is a sinner.’ The man answered, ‘Whether he is a sinner I don’t know; all I know is that I was blind and now I can see.’ They said to him, “What did he do to you? How did he open your eyes? He replied, I have told you once and you wouldn’t listen. Why do you want to hear it all again? Do you want to become his disciple, we are disciples of Moses: we know that God spoke to Moses, but as for this man, we don’t know where he comes from.’

The man replied, ‘That is just what is so amazing! You don’t know where he comes from and he has opened my eyes!

We know that God doesn’t listen to sinners, but God does listen to men who are devout and does his will. Ever since the world began it is unheard of for anyone to open the eyes of a man who was born blind; if this man were not from God, he wouldn’t have been able to do anything.

They retorted, ‘Are you trying to teach us, and you a sinner through and through ever since you were born!’ And they ejected him. John 9:13-17, 24-34.

Partial truths, this man was a sinner, but so were his accusers; all are under law so all are condemned as sinners.

These teachers of law believed their teachings had made them sinless before God. When all else fails the teachers of law bring the person out of the Spirit into their slavery through guilt. Teachers of law will not let themselves be taught outside of their doctrine - for those have not been perfected through their doctrine!

“When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature.

God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross. And having disarmed the powers and authorities he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross (stake/tree).

Freedom In Christ Vs Freedom of Doctrine

Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat and drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day.

These are a shadow of the things that were to come; *the reality*, however, *is found in Christ*. Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen; an unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions.

He has lost connection with the Head, for whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.

Since you died with Christ to the basic principles of this world, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules. Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch! These are all destined to perish with use, because they are based on human commands and teaching. Such regulation indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their self-imposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.” Col.2:11-23

Belonging To Christ Vs. Popularity of Men

We know the fruits of the Spirit we are children of God.

“But when the Holy Spirit controls our lives he will produce this kind of fruit in us; love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control; and here there is no conflict with Jewish laws.

Those who belong to Christ have nailed their natural evil desires to his cross and crucified them there.

If we are living now by the Holy Spirit’s power, let us follow the

Holy Spirit’s leading in every part of our lives. Then we won’t need to look for honors and popularity, which lead to jealousy and hard feelings.”
Gal.6:22-26

Child of God Vs. Fruits of Flesh

But does the child of God know the fruits of the flesh? And if he does can he determine when he is walking in the fruits of the flesh? Has the child of God grown in Christ wherein he discerns religious doctrine that produces fruits of the flesh?

Does he understand that all doctrine that brings the child of God under control of the flesh is not of the Spirit of God? Does the child of know that guilt through doctrine equals control, and control equals mislead, not lead by God Spirit?

“Make no mistake about this, my dear brother; all that is good, all that is perfect, is given us from above; it comes down from the Father of all lights; with him there is no such thing as alteration, no shadow caused by change.

By his own choice he gave birth to us by the message of the truth so that we should be a sort of first-fruits of all his creation. Remember this; my dear brothers, everyone should be quick to listen but slow so to speak and slow to human anger; God saving justice is never served by human anger; so do away with all impurities and remnants of evil. Humbly welcome the Word which has been planted in you and can save your souls.

But you must do what the Word tells you and not just listen to it and deceive yourselves. Anyone who listens to the Word and takes no action is like someone who looks at his own features in a mirror and, once he has seen what he looks like, goes off and immediately forgets it. But anyone who looks steadily at the perfect law of freedom and keeps to it - not listening and forgetting, but putting it into practice – will be blessed in every undertaking. James 1:16-25

Perfect Law of Love Vs. Law of Flesh

Does the child of God peer into the perfect law of freedom and understand that freedom law - is Christ Jesus?

Does he listen too the Word through the Spirit of God; the Spirit God that leads him, or does he listens to doctrine of men that judges Christ and the child of God too death? Does he understand who the “Word of God” is, or does he see the “Word of God” as interpretation of scriptures of men?

Is the child of God mislead; believing his Father Jehovah God is changing like shadows of lights as do the imperfect men and woman wherein, the organization he associates with? Does the child of God understand he will lack blessings of God - if he does not fully peer into Christ Jesus his Lord and Master?

Holy Spirit Filled Vs. Flesh Controlled

“Since you became alive again, so to speak, when Christ arose from the dead, now set your sights on the rich treasures and joys of heaven where he sits beside God in the place of honor and power.

Let heaven fill your thoughts; don’t spend your time worrying about things down here. You should have as little desire for this world as a dead person does. Your real life is in heaven with Christ and God.” Col.3:1-4

“For freedom Christ has set us free, stand fast therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery.

So long as a child of God looks to doctrine of men to set him free, he will find himself in slavery. So long as the child of God looks to church groups or religious organization for freedom he will be enslaved to men. So long as the child of God looks to men to set him free he will find himself in slavery. But when he looks to Christ Jesus and keeps his eyes focus on him, and him a lone - he will be set free. And if the Son of God set you free you are indeed set free!

“Jesus replied, “You are slaves of sin, every one of you. And slaves don’t have rights, but the Son has every right there is! So if the Son sets you free, you will indeed be free.” John 8:34, 35.

“But whenever anyone turns to the Lord from his sins, then the veil is taken away.

The Lord is the Spirit who gives them life, and where he is there is freedom (from trying to be saved by keeping the laws of God). But we Christians have no veil over our faces; we can be mirrors that brightly reflect the glory of the Lord. And as the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more like him.

As the child of God peers into the perfect law he sees Christ Jesus looking back at him. If he does not see Jesus Christ, but see imperfect doctrine of men he sees the angle of death. Christ Jesus is our Passover from death to life. Let the child of God peer intently until he sees the face of our Lord and Master in himself.

Ambassadors of Christ Vs. Ambassadors Earthly Organization

The child of God understands he is a representative of a heavenly Kingdom, the kingdom he represents is not human, or is it cut by human hands.

He understands that it is his reality and it is superior to anything and everything that has existed on this earthly. He understands he is not to create a substitute religious kingdom or government for his reality.

“Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor.

‘All this I will give you,’ he said, ‘if you fall down and worship me.’ Jesus said to him, ‘Away for me, Satan! For, it is written; ‘Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only.’ ” Matt.4:8-10

“We are Christ’s ambassadors, God is using us to speak to you; we beg you, as though Christ himself were here pleading with you, receive the love he offers you – be reconciled to God. For God took the sinless Christ and poured into him our sins. Then, in exchanges, he poured God’s goodness into us!” 2Cor.5:20, 21

“For the love of Christ controls us, because we are convinced that one has died for all; therefore all have died. And he died for all, that those who live no longer for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised.” 2Cor.5:14, 15

The child of God is to faithfully represent his Kingdom under war like conditions at the hands of ridiculers. He is sent into a hostile world of flesh that opposes the Spirit of the Living God, Jehovah. Make no mistake about it, this is not a feel good cake walk in the flesh! It is the hardest times God’s children have every faced, it is the time of full grown weeds called Christian.

Child of God Vs. Last Day’s Christians

“But understand this that in the last days there will come times of stress. For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, inhuman, implacable, slanderers, profligates, fierce, haters of good, treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,

holding a form of religion but denying the power of it. Avoid such people. For among them are those who make their way into households and capture weak women, burdened with sins and swayed by various impulses, who will listen to anybody and can never arrive at a knowledge of the truth.” 1Tim.3:1-7

“But the Holy Spirit tells us clearly that in the last times some of the church will turn away from Christ and become eager followers of teachers with devil inspired ideas.

These teachers will tell lies with straight faces and do it so often that their consciences won't even bother them. They will say it is wrong to be married and wrong to eat meat, even though God gave these things to well-taught Christians to enjoy and be thankful for. For everything God made is good, and we may eat it gladly if we are thankful for it, and if we ask God to bless it, for it is made good by the Word of God and prayer.”
1Tim.4:1-5

“And especially those who walk according to the flesh in the lust of uncleanness and despise authority. They are presumptuous, self-willed. They are not afraid to speak evil of dignitaries. Whereas angels, who are greater in power and might, do not bring a reviling accusation against them before the Lord.” 2 Pet.2:10, 11

Honesty of Sinner Vs. Self-Justification by Law

The child of God knows that all humans are sinners, but one and that one lived perfectly under the Law, that is, the head of their body, Christ Jesus.

“If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his world has no place in our lives. 1John 1:8-10

Now, putting the law, and our justification through our Master, Lord, and Savior, into human terms. That is, fleshly terms so the person without God's Spirit may understand true forgiveness:

It is physically impossible for anyone without thousands of hours of training to win an Olympic event and receive a gold medal.

If you were awarded the gold medal, but you had performed nothing! Not only had you performed nothing, but you reaped the benefits, the honor, and material gain, by receiving the gold medal; could you boast of being a superior athlete?

If you had committed a hideous crime against humanity, and was found guilty, thus, received the death penalty. Then suddenly you were released into society as a citizen with full benefits, plus rewarded monetary compensation from the courts. Could you boast in good works?

“Notice among yourselves, dear brothers, that few of you who follow Christ have big names or power or wealth.

Instead, God has deliberately chosen to use ideas the world consider foolish and of little worth in order to shame those people considered by the world as wise and great. He has chosen a plan despised by the world, counted as nothing at all, and used it to bring down to nothing those that world considers great. So that none anywhere can ever brag in the presence of God.

For it is from God alone that you have your life through Christ Jesus. He showed us God’s plan of salvation; he was the one who made us acceptable to God; he made us pure and holy and gave himself to purchase out salvation. As it says in the Scriptures, ‘If anyone is going to boast, let him boast only of what the Lord has done.’ ” 1Cor.1:26-31

Blessing of Spirit Vs. Death Roll

The child of God does not boast in himself, if he boasts he boasts in what Jesus Christ has done for him and the human race. God has given him a gift that he does not deserve nor has he or can he earn it.

The Law was perfect no human being could be perfectly fulfill it, so it condemned all of us to death. Christ did live according to God’s Law perfectly, thus, he received the benefits of the Law – life, life eternal.

The only way we can get off death roll and receive the gold metal – life – is by being a member of the Christ Jesus body.

Thus, for a child of God to separate himself from the head through law of doctrine of men; he has brought himself back to the very thing that causes death.

Once the child of God understands God's blessing flow through the head, Christ Jesus from God, and he puts himself under proper headship the curse is removed and blessings flow to him.

Loving the fleshly law of the mind makes everything a sin for the child of God. However, love has no law against it.

God's Rest Vs. Wrangling Works

When a child of God wrangles over scriptures in his mind; then he is diseased, no matter what noble reasoning he attaches to the wrangling outward or inwardly – (self-talk); it is diseased and death.

The child of God cannot justify himself through scriptures, when he does he loses his peace with God. The child of God is justified due too the blood of Christ. If Christ is righteous then the whole body must be declared righteous, thus, the child God cannot defend himself, God must defend the child of God, for he is the property of the living God.

When a child of God is consumed with self-justification he is no longer in God rest day, the Greater Sabbath of God. For him to enter into the Sabbath as a child of God, he must be in the Spirit, and resting from his own justification; flesh works, that is, justifying himself through his works.

“Today, as He says in David so much later, and as we mentioned heretofore, “Today, if you will hear His voice, do not harden your hearts.”

Joshua had given them rest; God would not have spoken of another day later on.

Consequently, there is Sabbath rest reserved for the people of God; for one who enters into his rest, by the same token rests from his works, just as God did from His own.” Heb.4:7-10

The fleshly law of the mind requires justification for all works, thus, it is by nature a hardener of hearts. Love and the fruits of the Spirit cannot abide under law it kills them into legal logic and determines who is worthy of God’s loving kindness and who is not.

Self-justification is the lot of those under the law, parsing sinful acts into groups of not so bad really bad sins. That is, which sins are more punishable by God - do to the law. Thus, Jesus told his disciples:

Measurement Vs. Judgment

“Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with measure you use, it will be measured to you.” Matt.7:1, 2.

How does one judge under a law that condemned us all to death? How does one say I am set free from God’s judgment, but he himself is under the law that condemns all sinners to death? The better question reminds; how can one not be judged by law?

“Be careful not to do your acts of righteousness before men, to be seen by them. If you do, you will have no reward from your Father in heaven.”
Matt.6:1

Sin! This sin is judged by law as losing your reward in heaven, have you every committed this sin? If so how can you now not be judged?

“Do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.” Matt.6:3b, 4.

Sin! Have you committed this sin in your life? How can you not be judged by the law for this sin?

“You have heard that it was said, ‘do not commit adultery.’ But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.” Matt.27, 28

Sin! Have you committed this sin at some time in your life? How does a person that is condemned to death for such an act - judge others?

“But I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, causes her to become an adulteress, and anyone who marries the divorced woman commits adultery.” Matt.5:31, 32

Sin! Have you every committed this sin or caused a woman to sin in this manner? How can you judge if you’re condemned in this sin?

“You have heard that it was said to the people long ago. ‘Do not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.

But I tell you that anyone who is angry with his brother will be subject to judgment.

Again anyone who says, ‘You fool!’ will be in danger of the fire of hell.” Matt.5:21, 22

Sin! The flesh loves judgment it can’t stop judging, the flesh has to judge by its nature. The flesh cannot stop judging because it is condemned under law. Thus, our transgression comes alive by law. The greater our justification, the greater our judgment. In other words, the greater our knowledge of the law the greater the transgression and judgment becomes too us.

“The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”
1Cor.15:56

Religions, that teaches the scriptures as law, that is, physical not spiritual. Will end becoming judges of law, the more they study the law the greater their knowledge of it becomes.

The clearer they see sins of others. Their judgments become harsher and merciless. At the same time their judgments clears the eyes of those being judged. Subsequently, the judged become their judges.

“But if you call yourself a Jew and rely upon the law and boast of your relation to God and know his will and approve what is excellent,

because you are instructed in the law, and if you are sure that you are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness, a corrector of the foolish, a teacher of children, having in the law a embodiment of knowledge and truth.

You who say that one must not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? You who boast in the law. Do you dishonor God by breaking the law? For, as it is written, the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you.”

Rom.2:17-24

Thus, it will be such at the end of this world for all those not walking by the Spirit of God. It will be the law that condemns all to death. The more those of the world judges the harder their heart becomes; soon there is no mercy left in the world, the love of the greater number cools off. The self-righteous Judges hearts become harden into blindness; thus, they can justify killing another human being over an infraction of the law! So will be the great tribulation to come.

“But because of your stubbornness and your unrepentant heart, you are storing up wrath against your self for the day of God’s wrath, when his righteous judgment will be revealed. God will give to each person according to what he has done. To those who by persistence in doing good seek glory, honor and immortality, he will give eternal life. But for those who are self-seeking and who reject the truth and follow evil, there will be wrath and anger.

There will be trouble and distress for every human being who does evil; first for the Jew, then for the Gentile. For God does not show favoritism.

All who sin apart from law will also perish apart from law, and all who sin under the law will be judge by the law. For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous.

Indeed when Gentiles, who do not have the law, do by nature things required by the law, they are a law for themselves,

even though they do not have the law, since they show that the requirements of the law are written on their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts now accusing, now even defending them. This will take place on the day when God will judge men's secrets through Jesus Christ, as my gospel declares." Rom. 2:5-16

We know that law blinds its user. Why? Because we are all sinners and condemn; there is but one correct answer and that answer is; we all need mercy and forgiveness. Lovers of the law are blinded to their own sins, hypocritically they judge without mercy and forgiveness. Yet, they themselves exist in slavery and sin.

They become haters of mercy the greater the hate grows through judgment the greater the blindness grows. Their minds are now diseased viewing everything as a transgression of law. They wrangle over the smallest letter of the law. Their lives are fear driven; God to them is a hateful merciless demanding Judge. Everything they read in Gods word the bible is negative, distrustful, and fear driven by their own hate and condemnation.

Subsequent, they are forced to live a lie why appearing beautiful outwardly to those they are convincing through their teachings of law regarding Christ Jesus and his promises.

It is nothing great; for Satan himself transforms himself into an angle of light. Satan used a divine law to enslave the human race to sin; it is no wonder that every divine law can be transformed into evil. The evil; to turn men away from God rather then bring them to God for forgiveness and freedom of their sins.

“Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother’s eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye. How can you say to your brother, ‘Let me take the speck out of your eye?’ Hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother’s eye.” Matt.7:3-5

This plank is the law that condemns all of us to death as a sinner. There is no way out of this death, but Christ Jesus. Only a person accepting Christ Jesus becoming a child of God will have this plank of death removed from his eye. Then and only then can he understand how to judge and judge correctly his brothers.

“But if you call yourself a Jew and rely upon the law and boast of your relation to God and know his will and approve what is excellent, because you are instructed in the law, and if you are sure that you are a guide to the blind, a light to those who are in darkness, a corrector of the foolish, a teacher of children, having in the law a embodiment of knowledge and truth.

You who say that one must not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? You who boast in the law. Do you dishonor God by breaking the law? For, as it is written, the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles because of you.”
Rom.2:17-24

A child of God knows there is the physical act of committing a sin against God, but there is also the spiritual act of committing sins against God. This act of sin come from the heart although it is not committed overtly it is committed nevertheless in his heart covertly.

Thus, only by the power of God’s Holy Spirit can cleanse a child of God from this sin of ones spirit and soul.

“Your have heard that it was said, ‘Do not commit adultery. But I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart.” Matt.5:27

There is nothing within the physical law that can remove this sin from the heart and spirit of men. It is impossible! This stain goes beyond the law into the very soul of mankind. There needs to be some sort of radical action under the law that might remove this sin:

‘If your right eye causes you to sin, gouge it out and throw it away. It is better for you to lose one part of your body that for your whole body to be thrown into hell.’ Matt.5:29

Radical indeed! Christ Jesus here is showing us the futility of man trying to remove this sin from him self under the law.

None of his apostle gouged out an eye, but all of them did receive the Holy Spirit of God and its circumcision of their hearts (a spiritual operation). Nor did any teach others to gouge out their eye.

“The Ten Commandments were given so that all could see the extent of their failure to obey God’s laws.

But the more we see our sinfulness, the more we see God’s abounding grace forgiving us. Before, sin ruled over all men and brought them to death, but now God’s kindness rules instead, giving us right standing with God and resulting in eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Rom.20, 21

“When you came to Christ he set you free from your evil desires, not by a bodily operation of the circumcision but by a spiritual operation, the baptism of your souls.

For in baptism you see how your old, evil nature died with him and was buried with him; and then you came up out of death with him into a new life because you trusted the Word of the mighty God who raised Christ for the dead.

You were dead in sins, and your sinful desires were not yet cut away. Then he gave you a share in the very life of Christ, for he forgave all your sins. And blotted out the charges proved against you, the list of his commandments which you had not obeyed.

He took this list of sins and destroyed it by nailing it to Christ's cross. In this way God took away Satan's power to accuse you of sin, and God openly displayed to the whole world Christ's triumph at the cross where your sins were all taken away."

Col.2:11-15

A child of God can judge correctly if he is walking in the Spirit and being led by the Spirit. For a child of God to be judge correctly by his brother that brother must be anointed and qualified by God's Holy Spirit or his judgment will be fleshly and incorrect! This should be self-evident to a child of God, but many have foolishly, let the judgments of physical men bring them back into slavery and bondage.

"Let me take the speck out of your eye, when there is a log in your own eye? You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye.

Do not give dogs what is holy; and do not throw your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under foot and turn to attack you."

Matt.7:4b-6.

"The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned. The spiritual man makes judgments about all things, but he himself is not subject to any man's judgment." 1Cor.2:14, 15

For physical men are eager to judge spiritual matters of the anointed children of God. It is their foolish nature of their flesh that they must prove themselves just and fair. Their nature is to judge, the scriptures are a law book onto them. Not unlike a dog that cannot determine because of his flesh if he is in the Holy presence of God or a trash can.

Blinded, by the mission to satisfy their flesh, which is, proving themselves righteous through their judgments. So be warned my brothers! Christ Jesus' judgment at the hands of these teachers of the law was a merciless cruel death on a torture stake.

An anointed Christian knows he is not fair and just without God's Holy Spirit, he knows he will condemn and make false judgments without God Spirit. He understands that it is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. He does not presume to know the mind of God.

Moreover, he knows God is the controller and corrector of His children and if God leads him to correct one of His children he better be in Christ and Christ Spirit speaking through him and not his flesh under law.

If he is not walking and being led by the Holy Spirit the judgment he renders must come back on him. For he has made an accusations against God's Holy ones.

“Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord. A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without recognizing the body of the Lord eats and drinks judgment on himself.”

That is why many among you are weak and sick and a number of you have fallen asleep. But if we judged ourselves, we would not come under judgment. When we are judged by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will not be condemned with the world. 1Cor.11:27-31

When a child of God judges according to the flesh he has sinned against the body of Christ Jesus that has been set free from judgment of law and death. Because the world has been judge by the law, thus, all are in death apart from Christ Jesus. The child of God finds himself out of Spirit in death of law.

He is then sick and weak spiritually and if continual in his false judgments of Christ body members he will go to sleep spiritually.

But even at this it is not with death in view he has received life from being part of the body Christ Jesus, God chose Him as such; so his judgment is with life in view until he can see clearly his condition in Christ Jesus.

When the plank is removed from his eye through His Fathers discipline he will see his wretched condition, repent of his judgments and be restored to life in the body of Christ.

“We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin. I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. And if I do what I do not want to do. I agree that the law is good.

As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out. For what I do is not the good I want to do; no, the evil I do not want to do – this I keep on doing.

Now if I do what I do I want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in men that does it.

So I find this law at work: When I want to do good evil is right there with me. For in my inner being I delight in God’s law; but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of the mind and making me a prisoner o the law of sin at work within my members.

What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? Thanks be to God – through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God’s law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set me free from the law of sin and death. Rom.7:14-25. Rom.8:1-2

Teachers of law without God’s Holy Spirit cannot understand the truths of the verses above. However, a child of God led by His Holy Spirit knows the truth of Paul’s words. The law condemn all human to death exposing their sinful evil nature. There is no way out of that death; thus, when a child of God returns to the law his evil nature controls his life. The more he proves himself through doctrine

of men the greater the law judges him into death, thus, the greater the sinful nature comes alive!

Finding in himself also in the love of God, because he is a child of God; he is tormented. This war wages until he is able to judge himself correctly, which is, he cannot judge himself at all under the law or by the doctrine of men. So his judgment must be left where it should, and where it belongs, with His Heavenly Father. God's judgment was completed at Christ death; so there is not another condemnation for those in Christ, their sin are remember no more!

These words are an apostasy to lover of law, they cannot conceive of God's love. God judges his children no more. For, the love of His Son. Christ Jesus took our judgment, that is, for his body members. If we are truly part of his body and believe the truth not the lie. God did not justify the head and not the body; we are one seed not many. When a religion teaches otherwise it is from the devil the father of the lie!

If a child of God cannot accept this truth and cannot put his faith in this, that is, believing Christ Jesus took our sins and judgments. In other words; if it is not enough and more is needed intellectually to be saved. Then he is in flesh under judgment of law once more!

When the child of God distorts in his mind God's love, forgetting all good gifts comes down to him from above, from the Father of lights; he has lost his faith in God's goodness. He is under fleshly law that condemns him to death. Not by God's choosing, but of his own desires he has condemned himself. Whether do to doctrine of men or wanting to please men.

No matter what his judgment of himself proves to be, or by what means, it is invalid in God's sight. God the Holy Father is not looking at him in judgment, he is looking at him as Christ Jesus body member. God has no judgment against his son!

The two are one, and we are from one seed, that is, all of Christ Jesus body members, not many seeds, not many bodies, not many heads, not many members each proving themselves righteous. One person proved himself righteous, Christ Jesus.

You are joined to him if you are in Christ Jesus and believe this. Your righteous come through Christ Jesus as part of his body. The very reason you exist as a son of God is do to the blood of Christ Jesus that bought you from sins condemnation and slavery.

When you as a child of God and finds yourself under judgment; do not be deceived it is not from God. You are under law and that judgment condemns you to death and heightens your sinful nature. Your judgment comes through your own natural mind; and its value will be reaped in death.

“Don’t be misled; remember that you can’t ignore God and get away with it: a man will always reap just the kind of crop he sows!

If he sows to please his own wrong desires, he will be planting seeds of evil and he will surely reap a harvest to spiritual decay and death; but if he plants the good things of the Spirit, he will reap the everlasting life which the Holy Spirit give him.” Gal.6:7-10

Who then will rescue you out of this death? Be it as it may nothing but your faith in the Son of God.

When you rest in him and accept his judgment of you, that is, no man every hated his own body but feeds and cherish it. Then loving life is restored through God’s Holy Spirit. The promise gifts of the Holy Spirit will reside in you richly. These gifts have no law against them; they are purer and come down from above. Don’t be deceived!

“For He who said, ‘Do not commit adultery,’ also said. ‘Do not murder,’ Now if you do not committed adultery, but do murder, you have become a transgressor of the law.

The Superiority of Love

So speak and so do as those who will be judged, by the law of liberty. For judgment is without mercy to the one who has shown no mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment. James 2:11-13

“Owe no one anything, except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law. The commandments, ‘You shall not commit adultery.’ ‘You shall not kill.’ ‘You shall not steal.’ ‘You should not covet,’ and any other commandments, are summed up in this sentence. ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’

Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.” Rom. 13:8-10

Love Vs. Obligations

There is no law against love; love is a desire to please some one without limits. Not being made to obey through obligation. Law says you must love, when a person must do something it is not of his free will, or his complete heart, mind, or soul. It is the will of another! Obligations can be good or bad, they are but requirements place on us by someone that wants some need meant.

The child of God understands that God is not a hypocrite, that is, he knows God cannot ask of him what God is not. And yet the fleshly minded person sees God putting obligations on them they can't perform, that is, requirements only God can perform.

Their view is negative of God and His love. They see love as law determined by doctrine of men. Law is negative by nature it assumes wrong doing before it assumes good. It cannot produce life because it is planted in wrong doing and sin. Thus, if you plant wrong doing and sin your reap death.

Jehovah God the Almighty says of Himself to the child of God that He is Love. Speaking of Himself He states:

“Love is very patient and kind, never jealous or envious, never boastful or proud, never haughty or selfish irritable or touchy. It does not hold grudges and will hardly even notice when other s do it wrong. It is never glad about injustice, but rejoices whenever truth wins out. If you love someone you will be loyal to him no matter what the cost. You will always believe in him, always expect the best of him, and always stand your ground in defending him.” 1Cor.13:4-7

Love has no law against it; love is not a negative view, assuming wrong doing before good. Love cannot be restricted by doctrine of men it is like the wind, limitless, endless and blows where it wants. Love produces life and light in those that receive it. Thus, the child of God has a freedom that is limitless in Christ love. The head is loved by Father with endless love, thus, we as members belonging to each other, receive the same love through the head of Jesus Christ.

Love Vs. Impossibility of Law

How can a person love their neighbor as themselves? The child of God knows that it is humanly impossible under the law to love someone as themselves. However, with the fruits that come down from the Father of lights and His goodness as a gift to us it is supernaturally possible. With men it is not possible, but all things are possible with God.

Thus, the child of God understands that he must be part of the vine of Christ or he cannot produce such fruits. He also understands the requirements of love are far above the law, not less than, or equal too the law.

Subsequently, he knows that God did not lower his standards through love, but through great mercy (Christ Jesus is our mercy) gave us power through His Holy Spirit to come up to loves requirements, thus, we can love our neighbor as ourselves, and our enemies now because of God's love too us and working through us.

So when a child of God falls, that is, (*because he is raised up with Christ who seated with God*), from understanding the power of God's love to him and working through him. He finds that he does not have the power within himself to love others as God loves him. Many fall into this trap fooling themselves thinking far too much of their own goodness outside his Lord and Master the true vine, deceived by seeking their own glory. In other words, the gifts of the Holy Spirit are gifts for the body working through the body. The gift is a gift to be used to glorify God not ourselves.

Thus, doing so the child of God is worshiping a lesser idol a demy god. Wanting to please men for their adulation for the gifts he received from His Father. He shares only to be glorified in his fleshly state of mind. Foolishly believing that godly devotion is a means of great gain.

He takes what Christ his head refused to take, that is, the glory that is do to his Father.

Faith Vs. Obligation

God has places obligation on men for protection and control of evil deeds. Some men do these obligations because they love God producing a pure faith. Other men do them because they hate God, or they don't want to lose relationships with other, or out of fear of being punished, or for personal gains and position. Some can't do them at all because of their fleshly desires are too strong within themselves.

But none can do God's obligation perfectly according to God's standards of justice. Some men/woman love God's ways so much that they are tormented, (*fear is a torment; fear of punishment*) knowing that they can never reach His high standards of justice. Yet, they have trust in God that He must find a way too help them. For God, is not only perfect in justice, but He also is perfect in love.

Faith = trust, trust in God, trust that God is who He says He is, that He is Love. Trust means that God is looking to His children for good not bad.

When a person trusts God to do what is correct and believes what God says he will do, they are putting faith in God/trust. God must act because He is not negatively; bond by law - He is Love

God justice requires that a penalty be paid for sin. But He is Love; so there be no law against God; God is love, that is, Love is He. And because He is love it is about what He has done and is doing and will do for mankind out of love. It is future positive, powerful, unbreakable, and unshakeable. Love is His Being; limitless, boundless, and endless. Those under the law of the flesh defined love in the negative; in the past, restrictive, guilt, fear, and death.

God cannot be defined in the negative wherein a person walks in love. Where bad is, God abounds in good! Where death is, God abounds in life!

Love Vs. Fallen Flesh

The child of God understands by God Spirit what the true nature of man fallen flesh is. Man must be brought up, for man to be brought up he must see his true condition in the flesh in the light of love. Thus, man must look into the mirror of Law to see his imperfection. Closely examining himself against the law he clearly sees those imperfections. He does not see love, but he sees no mercy, unkindness, condemning himself into death through penalty of law.

The child of God knows that the law is perfect and it is good although it condemns him to death.

God is Love so the law must be good for it is from God. Without law man cannot come up, that is, without insight into his true condition he stays in death without hope. Although condemning him into death; he now able to see much more a need for something greater and what is needed is mercy for his sins against God.

Mercy Vs. Law

Now we understand that only a God of Love can provide such great mercy! God is his only hope in bring him out of his sin. He now sees his sin stains is into his very soul and it is part of his fiber, his very nature of being. If God is not Love he is stuck in death and condemnation of his sinful nature. Animal blood sacrifices cannot remove this type of sin; although merciful as they were; they only gave a foretaste of the greatest love ever offered to mankind.

No Law Against Love Vs. Law of the Flesh

Thankfully, for the child of God there is no law against love and the fruits of God Spirit.

Because, without love, knowledge, gifts, prophesying, and the very sacrificing of our bodies are of no value to bring us out from under the law of death. Only God's love to us and through his Son Christ Jesus bring us out of death into life; so now we can have God's love and life in us.

Love Vs. Faith Knowledge/Law

The highest degree a child of God can obtain to is love. If he cannot go beyond knowledge, he is in death.

But when he peers into the perfect law of love he is transformed into the face of Christ Jesus. He no longer sees his imperfections, but forgiveness, and loved. He is filled with no law, he is filled with the Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God His Heavenly Father.

He now understands what Adam lost in the beginning with the first sin; and that was God's love; and in that day Adam died! He was no longer connected in love to his Maker. He found himself under the penalty of law and death.

For without God's love a son of God has no life. God loved the world so much that He gave us His only begotten Son Jesus Christ. For mankind to true accept what was lost by the first sin, they must clearly see where they are in sin and the human race. They must understand what corruption of sin and death has done. Then and only then can they fully be aware that they are alienated from God's of love.

Good Vs. Death

The law must be good the God of love produces only good, good comes from Gods, so the fruits of law must be good. Though the law produces death in us its fruits bring us to the reality of sin and the need for God's love.

So even in death the law, God gives good; for God is life and love, there is no law against God, so he can go deeper, into death and love us while we our yet sinners. God can now reveal who he is and what has been lost by his first children and that is His love.

Why we are in an unrighteous state separated from God by our sin living in darkness without God's Holy Spirit he sends us His love through His Son Christ Jesus; while we are weak and in sin.

Even in our sin and unrighteousness God is glorified, when God is being judge by the unrighteous world under Satan. God does them good; where the greatest evil exists he blesses his enemies through His love. Let God be found true though all men are found to be liars.

Faith's Love Vs. Faith's Justice

When the child of God response to his Father in love, that is, in faith, the highest degree of faith, love! He is connects to the God of Love. God acts towards His child according to love. But when the child of God responses to God in justice he is connected to the law and he is condemn to death by the law.

God's justice brings us to God, creating in us a fear of death and punishment. God justice should create in us honesty of heart, that is, we now know without doubt we are sinners condemned to death. Justice should create in us humility, that is, our salvation come through one way and that way is the way God approves, that is, His Son Christ Jesus. We understand for our relationship to be restored with God it has to come through love - not justice. It cannot come through justice; justice calls for our death nothing more. Love looks for the good, brings us up and back to God for forgiveness of our sin and transgression against the God's justice.

For the honest hearted and humble person their hearts has been humble through their failings to meet God justice, thus, brings them perfectly to God's love. But for those that are proud and haughty their hearts will be hardened by the law.

Their hypocrisy will become greater and known to all. Their conscious defiled for living a lie. God did not create man live a life in a lie. God is love and truth, so are we created in love and truth.

For a person to live in a lie, the lie will corrupt his mind, soul, and spirit. The only way out of this disease and corruption is to be recreated in Christ Jesus – a new!

Not the putting of new wine into old wineskins, not sowing a new patch onto and old garment. But a new creation one made without hands, not from this earth and its corruption. No! But perfectly, sinless, through God's great spiritual temple in Christ Jesus.

Jehovah God does not fix the old personality He creates a new personality by His Holy Spirit: He does not translate the old personality into the head of the temple Christ Jesus. He translating us into His Son's love, by killing the old personality with Christ at his torture stake and resurrection us seating us with

Christ Jesus in the heavens all this transpires will we are yet on earth in fleshly bodies.

Foolishly living a lie that a child of God cleanses himself through law, translating himself in to God love through law or doctrine is sin and death.

Claiming doctrines sanctified the child of God and knowledge, declares them righteous before God. Is walking in a lie and living a lie! Christ Jesus showed light on this darkness brightly blinding lovers of law by God's Holy Spirit.

Moreover, claiming God creates His new creation by law and not love is the ultimate of lie of Satan. That is, drinking of spring of water producing both sweet and bitter. Christ is the living water producing life, that comes down from above giving us the Holy Spirit of God. He dwells in the unapproachable light, which is uncorruptible, immortal, and untouchable by human sin produced by the law!

God's Faithfulness Vs. Mans Faith

God must act on our faith; faith does not have to be perfect for God to act upon it. Faith can be trust in God's justice or it can be trust in His love. God will act on both kinds of faith. One is a lower form of faith, being based on law and justice. The other is a higher or highest form of trust that is based on love.

All of God children will be perfected in their faith based on the highest form of trust in God, and that is in His love.

Many of the prophets had a love based faith and many did not. The prophets that loved God's heart provided a link to the children of God. But God can and does act upon both types faiths.

When a child of God is perfected in love, his faith has been made perfect. The faith he had at the start may have been in a God's of justice, but the faith he has at his finish must be in God's love and kindness too him.

Thus, there are two groups of faiths on earth. The majority bases their faith on God's justice viewing God in the negative form of punishment - not love. Their faith is formed through law.

Love's Personality Vs. Laws Personality

Without the enforcement of the law they believe man cannot serve God faithfully. In other words, man cannot serve God out of love. God acts on their faith and it is enough to bring them to the feet of the Christ.

Once brought to Christ Jesus they continually forming their faith in accordance with law and doctrine. Creating as it were; a legal document of faith with God; an air tight contract filled with iron clad doctrine. They cannot produce the new personality, because they cannot produce the beautiful fruits of God's Holy Spirit, which creates the new person according to God's love

Thus, they create the new man according to punishment of evil acts. Through laws, and doctrine of men. Boasting as it were, in and of themselves by the power of their doctrine. Subsequently, the group refines the old personality through law into acceptable person that obeys the rules of the church or an organization. The process is affective, as have been refining school that use fleshly techniques. That is, creating refined persons to fit into upper crust of societies.

Child of God Vs. Doctrinal Foolishness

However, when confronted with a Spirit through a child of God not contained in their legal doctrine they are confounded and fearful of his child like trust in God's love. They see him as foolish outside their religious doctrine. They cannot judge his action correctly by their doctrine, the greater their judgment becomes the greater their own judgment becomes.

There is no stopping this process it is a war of Spirit and flesh. The flesh judges while the Spirit forgives. The flesh/law god contained in their doctrine is not a real person. He is a legal Judge so they must judge to uphold his standards. In other words, by judging they please God so they have no fear of judging. They fear not judging and displeasing the God they worship.

The group sees the child of God as arrogant, not humble because he cannot obey the dictates of men under law without losing God's favor, that is, God's Holy Spirit.

Nor, can he compromise the truth that resides within him without living a lie.

The love of God compels the child of God to tell the truth at all cost. If he hides Christ light in him, then he has not given his life for his master, for which, he called too.

Moreover, he does not have the love for which his master gave his life for, that is, God's loved the world so much he gave His only begotten Son Christ Jesus.

Because laws foundation is not based on Spirit, that is, the Spirit begotten Son of God, but fleshly law; their faith is in men idolized in their doctrines. They produce the fruits of the flesh that are outlawed by their own laws.

Furthermore, their laws produce division of the flesh in their groups, not the unity of love through God's Holy Spirit. In order to justify and rectify fleshly divisions among themselves, the group uses many forms of guilt in forming and controlling actions of their flocks.

Some of these organizations disfellowship/excommunicate of flock members according their laws and doctrine to maintain unity. Others punishes through hell fire doctrine, or still other purgatories.

The freedom in Christ, which is, God trusting His children; is blinding to them! It creates fearful thoughts of people out of control living in sin. Moreover, creating, fear of the loss of their organizations power over their flock. Causing huge finical loses; by flock members no longer needing their services

They cannot understand God personally loving and teaching His own children, God is not capable of those actions according to their doctrine.

Moreover, they cannot conceive Christ apostles and the teachers of the early congregation were gifts given to the body of Christ – not too an organization. They were all equal, not greater then the body of Christ Jesus. They were but a part of the whole, not the owners of the body.

Nor can they understand God did not put teachers over his children who were not led by His Holy Spirit. Nor can they understand God gave gifts in these men are through the Holy Spirit, gifts of the body, and for his body. Not gift for organization, they were not gifts in and of themselves, they were gifts of the body; through the body, and by the body, for the body of Christ Jesus. Gifts given through God's love freely, not gifts to enforce laws or restrict the members of the body from freedom in love.

Nor can a lover of law and flesh understand that the body of Christ Jesus is still alive and will never die. Nor, can they understand the gifts are always living because the body lives. Thus, the body is always being feed through the Holy Spirit at all times in this world for two thousands years. God does not need physical men in an organization changing like a shadow feeding his body. Nor, does a he use man with special gifts too give gifts to His children. God's children have always been in the body of Christ Jesus. That is, the gift he that took captive in men for his reward when proving faithful to His Father Jehovah God onto death.

God's children can be on death roll in prison and God promises to feed them His beautiful gifts of the Spirit without the help of any living person. God wants to take care of them; His delight in giving good gifts to His children. His hands are not tie by foolish men of fleshly doctrines. God has no laws against Him, he is love and nothing can stop Him from feeding his children, and teaching them the truth all men must yet learn. Man does not live on bread alone, but every utterance coming from the mouth of God.

When children of God comes together in two or more they share in greater measure the gifts of God in their brothers, but they do not share in mundane law. The rules and doctrine that have to be understood perfectly so there is no violation of! No! They share in God's Holy Spirit in an increase measure of love and freedom; gifts of joy, peace, kindness, faith, and love. They are not confined again to the law. They are not tormented by hundreds of do's and don't on how to please God, and all the fear it produces. There is no law against the gifts of God Spirit.

When they come to gather in love and the Spirit they do not have pen and pencil in hand waiting for new light. They are the light of the world and dwell in the light, and their God gives to them freely and in abundances in scripting His

love into their hearts; where no one on earth can break into and steal by fleshly men loving doctrinal law.

They come to the greatest of all gift love which surpasses all other gifts even that of knowledge. They are at home away from the flesh and corruption of this world they need no law making them associate with the body they are part of! No! That is as foolish as telling your hand it must be part of your body! No! Your body goes to a meeting so you have to make your hand go?

The child of God knows the weeds of false Christianity have over grown the field of God in are times; the last days. They do not live in fear if they can't associate with weeds of flesh that God will punish them.

God has promised He cannot leave them. The child of God knows he is under no such law. God is not all of sudden condemning His children, subsequently, changing like a shadow of light from good to bad. The child of God knows when false bothers twist the scriptures into another law, that is, you must gather with weeds of flesh. No! The child of God is not under the law, but the commandment of love not law. He wants to associate with his anointed brothers and sisters, the law can not make him do nothing, but die.

However, when he does find those of the living temple, the congregation of God, those being led and built upon by God's Spirit? Nothing in this world can separate the child of God from associating with his family accept doctrine of men that cannot see or understand the body of Christ for blindness!

Love Vs. Control and Fear

Driven by fear the losing control of their legal contract of faith with God, they search the scriptures to rebut this apostasy against their doctrine. Wherein, searching the scriptures they find inconsistency of their own doctrinal faith and are most often devastated, many fall away and become hater of God instead of blaming doctrine of men. Because, they are so fleshly lovers of law, once tricked by Satan through organization they cannot trust again.

Their minds cannot separate law and God, the fear of being wrong again dominates their very being.

The law they were under produces fear and distrust as it should, that is, of their own hearts being misled

Instead of turning to God they turn to other rules of laws to bring the control back into their lives that are being driven by fear. Their foundation was never built on Christ the rock mass by the Holy Spirit.

Many find no relief except through rules of doctrine that condemns God and His Word Christ Jesus. Nevertheless, they are judges against themselves the more they judge God, the greater their fear and anger becomes.

They are sinners in death, thus, falsely believing judging God will somehow bring Him into sin and death and pay Him back for evil placed on them and mankind, thus, falsely proving there is no God! That he is but an imagination of men through a fearful mind.

Because they walk in the flesh, their minds are in a natural state of wrangling doctrine; thinking in their diseased mind they are faithfully upholding moral standards. When in fact, they have thrown love outside in darkness; and are living in fear; where God does not exist!

God is a Spirit and those worshiping Him must worship in Spirit and truth. God children on earth are conceived by God's Holy Spirit. The only way a new born child of God can grow into adult children of God, is by nourishment through God's Holy Spirit by the Word Jesus Christ.

God Teaching His Children Vs. Accurate Knowledge Teaching

When God created Adam He created a complete man, Adams education came from God Himself (Adam was a son of God). Adam needed no teacher placed on earth for his education. A child of God is a new creation a higher creation than Adam; they are born of Holy Spirit not flesh and blood. God personally foreordained them before the founding of the world. God did not hold back He gave the very life of His own begotten Son Jesus Christ to redeem each part of his body.

For the child of God, it is not strange that God Himself teaches him? He knows his birth, life, and, resurrection comes from the same Holy Spirit that

teaches him. He knows he is baptized by the Holy Spirit and that he is fed by the body of Christ because he is a part of his spiritual body filled with God's Holy Spirit. He understands that Christ Jesus is the living spiritual temple of God and because he is a part of his body than he too is God's temple on earth; not made with hands, but by God Holy Spirit.

But for those walking in the flesh they find this talk contemptible, offensive, and inconceivable. Yet, God is a good parent; He does not send His children into the world and let doctrine of men teach them. A good parent finds it inconceivable that the State takes their children and forbade them from communicating with their children until adulthood. Once at adulthood; the child then condemns their parents for not communicating and caring for them personally! Thus, the child takes state position and prosecutes the parents for neglect by advocating the doctrines of State over love of parent.

Those walking in the flesh that avocation religion over Holy Spirit take just such a foolish course; presumptuously assuming God would have a man made religion take His children making them orphans; giving them over to doctrine of men. Such thinking is unscriptural and against the very reason Christ Jesus came from heaven was born not of man, but of God's Holy Spirit.

Still the fleshly lover of law fines this talk blasphemous, so they presumptuously accuse the child of God of putting himself above the great teachers of their doctrine or organization.

Thus, pleasing men over the truth of God's word. They would have a child of God condemn their Heavenly Father through doctrine of men, denying the Holy Spirit within them.

Love does not obligate God to give His Holy Spirit to His Child. No! God wants and does give His Holy Spirit not by measure as the law gives, but openly and freely to his children. His Spirit teaches them all the good things their Father has for them now, and also the good things to come. God makes it rain on the wicked and the righteous: So should it be a small thing that God shares His Holy Spirit with His own children? Judas shared in the Holy Spirit working through Christ Jesus. Should God not give His Holy Spirit in abundance to those loving Him?

Only lovers of law rather than a lovers of God would think by their doctrine they could dictate to God who He gives His Holy Spirit to. Foolishness is tied up in the heart of a boy. Only a fleshly child under tutorship of law could imagine such unbelievable biblical fantasy as this!

“It is written in the prophets, ‘And they shall all be taught by God.’ Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me.’

Not that anyone has seen the Father, except He who is from God; He has seen the Father.

Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has every lasting life. I am the bread of life; your fathers ate the manna in the wilderness, and are dead. This is the bread which comes down from heaven that one may eat and not die.’ ” John 6:45-50

“And you shall remember all the ways which the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness;

that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments, or not. And he humbled you and let you hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know, nor did you fathers know, that he might make you know that man does not live by bread alone, but that man lives by every thing that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD.”

Deut.8:2, 3.

Christ Jesus is the fulfillment of manna maliciously feeding his sheep as the Word of God. The written word (scriptures), are written about the Word of God, is not Jesus Christ the very Word of God! Shall the physical written word of God now be made greater than Christ Jesus?

Should we put more power into the letters written about God’s love too us Jesus Christ, than God’s Love - Jesus Christ himself?

If Christ is not the reality of our faith then who is? If Christ has not been raised and glorified at God's right hand then all that is written about him is of no value. Is our faith in a book, not the reality that exists powerfully in heaven seated at God right hand, pleading for us. Is he not the savior of our faith!

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God.”
John 1:1a

“Before anything else existed, there was Christ, with God.”
John 1:1a

“So Jesus said it again. ‘With all the earnestness I possess. I tell you this, ‘Unless you eat the flesh of the Messiah and drink his blood, you cannot have eternal life within you.

But anyone who does eat my flesh and drink my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him at the Last Day.

For my flesh is true food, any my blood is the true drink. Everyone who eats my flesh and drinks my blood *is in me, and I in him*. I live by the power of the living Father who sent me, and in the same way those who partake of *me shall live because of me.*’ “ John 6:53-57

Those confined to doctrine cannot imagine Christ living in them and through them, they think of him as an impersonal savior bound in a hard copy of their bibles. They cannot feel his power of Christ speaking through them. Their own will is crystallized in doctrine of men too the point that the wind or Spirit can't led them where it wants.

“Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of Spirit is spirit.” John 3:5, 6.

Doctrine produces - doctrine born of flesh. Spirit produce spirit that born of God. Not by mans will, but by God's will. There can be only one will for the child of God, and that is the will of his Father in heaven. God's will is like the wind it does exactly as God wishes.

When a child of God conflicts the will of man over the will of God he cannot be led or fed by God's Holy Spirit.

Should the father of our faith (Abraham), had listen to mans doctrine and their interpretation of the written word during his time; he could not have offer up Isaacs his son to God. Nothing within the written word found place for such action.

Impressive as institutions may be, they do not allow for God's Spirit to teach His own children. Their politics, that is, personal interest, power, prestige, and immortalizing the great founder of their doctrine, out weigh the love of God.

“For if the word spoken through angels prove steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, how shall we escape

if we neglect so great a salvation, which as the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him.”
Heb.2:2, 3

“For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit and have tasted the good Word of God and the power of the age to come.

If they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame.” Heb.6:4-6

“Follow the pattern of the sound words which you have heard from me. The truth that has been entrusted to you by the Holy Spirit who dwells within us. 2Tim.1:13, 14

“Then he saved us – not because we were good enough to be saved, but because of his kindness and pity – by washing away our sins and giving us the new joy of the indwelling Holy Spirit. Whom he poured out upon us with wonderful fullness and all because of what Jesus Christ our Savior did.” Titus 3:5, 6.

“To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven – thing which angels desire to look into.” 1Pet. 1:12

Living Stones Vs. Man Made Temples

“Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious,

You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual home, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.” 1Pet.2:4, 5.

Christ Jesus is not a dead stone in the foundation of a church or an organization.

He is full of Holy Spirit precious to God. He offers up spiritual sacrifices as High Priest for us daily. A child of God is part of the body, thus, he is a precious stone a part of the spiritual house the temple of God of the Living God; offering up spiritual sacrifices to God daily.

If the child of God does not listen to the Spirit as it speaks to the living congregation of God he cannot be built into the spiritual house that God has prepared from the founding of the world for the salvation of fallen mankind.

“For the body without spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.” James 2:26

“For Christ also suffered once for sins, that just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit.” 1Pet.3:18

“For the Holy Spirit will teach you at that time what you should say.”
Matt.12:12

“If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to you children, how much more will your father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!” Luke 11:13

“The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach goodness to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed, to proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor.” Luke 4:18, 19.

Christ freed no one physically while on earth from prison not even John the Baptists the greatest of the prophets until Christ Jesus.

But he did make us truly free through God’s Holy Spirit no longer oppressed under the Law of death, but alive through the Living God in complete freedom of God’s love. How foolish for a child of God to go back to prison under torment and death!

“For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit. The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands.” John 3:34, 35

“If you love me, obey me; and I will ask the Father and he will give you another Comforter, and he will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, the Spirit *who leads into all truth.*” John.14:15, 16.

The child of God must ask; can he know the truth without God’s Holy Spirit? Shall the child of God leave his Father (Jehovah God) and mother (Holy Spirit) and marry the doctrine of men. Shall he trade the promises of Christ never to leave him without the Holy Spirit to be joined to flesh? Shall he place his eternal life in the hands of corruptible green grass?

“But when the Father sends the Comforter instead of me – and by the Comforter I mean the Holy Spirit – *he will teach you much, as well as remind you of everything I myself have told you.*” John 14:26

“Then, when that happens, we are able to hold our heads high no matter what happens and know that we feel this warm love everywhere within us because God has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love.”
Rom.5:5

“But you are not in the flesh; you are in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.” Rom.8:9

For if you live according to the sinful nature, you will die; but if by the *Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body*, you will live, because those who are led by Spirit of God are sons of God.

For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship.” Rom.8”13a -15.

How can a child of God put to death the sinful nature of his flesh without the Holy Spirit?

Certainly not by trading the Holy Spirit for no spirit through teachings of men bring more sin - into the temple? Polluting, his soul, spirit, and mind. A child of God’s knows he cannot put to death fleshly sins - through law, the more he prays for physical well power the greater he finds his problem to be; the greater the condemnation of the flesh! He must be under God’s will, and through God’s will; God’s will gives him the power by the Holy Spirit to conquer his sins

When a child of God is unable to confess his sins openly because of fear and condemnation of men under doctrine, he is doubly condemned. However, when he confesses his sins to a brother under Holy Spirit that is led by the Spirit of God; he will find he has no condemnation, but healing.

Let not the child of God be deceived here, the congregation of God is his temple on earth. Not a physical church or organization, No! But living stones; the Holy priesthood of anointed worshipers of the Living God. That means to those without understand the temple of God is Spiritual not physical, the temple are bodies of flesh, anointed by God, and filled with His Holy Spirit.

The flesh is but a tent temporary, and of no value at all, it is the living Spirit of God that holds eternal light and life for the child of God.

The temple is the real, it is temple of God where He resides, not the physical temple or churches built by men. The temple also is used by God to offer up spiritual sacrifice. In other word, the body of Christ, isn't separated into feet, hands, and eye, or body parts used for transplants into many bodies. Some having functions, and other not useful at; having no value.

Speaking now of sacred things. The child of God is offering up sacrifice not just for himself, but also for the sins of others as they are being brought into the spiritually temple.

The child of God need not ever be confused in this matter. That is, many of his fights from within with regards the flesh are most often not his sins.

They are do to those he associates with, other body members through the Spirit; he is connected to body by the Spirit – he is not connected just to the head, but the entire body - all of its parts. When one become weak all are affected until there has been made acceptable spiritual sacrifice by Christ to his Father. A child of God may share in the sins of others filling up the measure for the body of Christ. Now because the child of God is declared sinless, does not mean, he is not dealing with sin; those of his own and those of others.

Let not the child of God be fooled here by Satan into the guilt of the law. The God given anointing he posses give him a position by the Holy Spirit into priesthood of living stones. The high priest Jesus Christ is his head and we are in the body of Christ. Thus, we are one of many stones in the Great Spiritual Temple under the workmanship of God.

“But into the second part the high priest went alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and for the people’s sins committed in ignorance; The Holy Spirit indicating this, that the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing.

It was symbolic for the present time in which both gifts and sacrifices are offered which cannot make him perfecting regards to conscience.

Concerned only with foods and drinks, various washing, and fleshly ordinances imposed until the time reformation.” Heb 9: 7-10

The physical temple dealt with flesh because it dealt with the law, as the law was not the real law, nor the physical temple, the real temple, but only shadows of the good things to come. The reality would deal with Spiritual matters in a Spiritual temple.

“How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot from dead works to serve the living God?

Law and flesh cannot be brought into the Spiritual temple, the spiritual temple is not administering death through the law, but life through the Holy Spirit. When flesh is brought into the temple through sin, that is, law into freedom; it must be dealt with brought under captivity and made holy through the administering of the new covenant by Holy Spirit.

These sins are weakness of flesh, that is, the law, thus, laws weakness within the body must be perfected through the body of Christ into freedom; that is, not one letter of the law goes unfulfilled through the body of Christ and in this manner corruptions and futility of creation will be set free through the son’s of God.

“For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it in hope; because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.
Rom.7:20, 21

In the physical temple of God on earth when flesh was brought into the temple for guilt offerings; once in the temple it was made holy. The priest offering up sin offering must eat of the flesh guilt. In other words, fleshly guilt offering according to the law must be eaten and shared in by those priests within the temple service. All were under law, so to all are under death of the law. All must share in the law and guilt of the law, so all share the death of the law.

“Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, ‘This is the law of the offering; in the place where the burnt offering is killed, the sin offering shall be killed before the LORD, it is most holy.

The priest who offers it for sin shall eat it, in the holy place it shall be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of meetings. Everyone who touches its flesh must be holy. And when its blood is sprinkled on any garment, you shall wash that on which it was sprinkled, in a holy place.” Leviticus 6:25-27

The law perfected nothing it only produce death. The blood sacrifices produced death, temporary allowing a standing before God. So the law is represented by the flesh and physical; as was the temple made of physical materials that is temporary. But all were made holy when brought into God’s present within the physical temple, the flesh, and the law.

For Christ has not entered the holy place made with hands, which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us.” Heb.9:14,24

The child of God is anointed into a royal priesthood, thus, sharing in life, life eternal. He is a part of the Great Spiritual Temple the body of Christ. He partakes of the life giving Holy Spirit within the temple, which also the temple is constructed of. Thus, he is holy and declared righteous because he is in the temple of the Living God. He eats of the Holy Spirit the Word of God, He lives because of the power of the Holy Spirit and he walks and is led by the Holy Spirit. It is God’s will for him to complete his work on earth within the Great Spiritual Temple of God, that is, Christ Jesus; a temple not made with hands.

The child of God before he was anointed may have conquered most sins, but once anointed he may find the sins he once dealt with having come alive again. Thus, making him think he is unworthy of such a high calling because of these sins. He is trick by Satan or through doctrine of men. He condemns himself into death. Whereby, in fact, he is dealing not with his own sin, as familiar as may seem to him, but actually and factually the sins of others.

The child of God must understand that the whole creation was subjected to futility by His Heavenly Father through the Law producing death.

Where death is God is not, where death is there is fear and torment. As a priest of God he is dealing with the law daily by administering the Spirit to others, that is, other members of the body or people God divinely appoints him to associate with.

Where sin and law is allowed to conquer the Spirit in the child of God; death, fear, and torment come alive. However, without this operation the creation cannot be set free from enslavement of death and corruption. The child of God is declared righteous of his sins.

Those sins are dealt with at his anointing; by his anointing he now shares in Christ death and resurrection and is grafted into the body of Christ as a member. The head is holy so are its members!

When death and law is brought into the Temple of God it must be dealt with through the administering of the Spirit which God has qualified the child of God to administer. In this process the child of God suffers, and by this suffering the child of God's faith is being made perfect. The same as his Lord and Master faith was made perfect through suffering of the law.

“As it is written: “For Your sake we are killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.” Rom.8:36

We are slaughter through law of the sins of others, but can we maintain faith in God promises, do we trust in these times of torment God's love is with us and His love will never leave us? Can we remember that despite the suffering of sins that feels and act like are own that God will deliver us? Can we bear the pain and sufferings of the Christ in are body and its members, yes! Where law and death fails us – God's love prevails through us.

“Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who love us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, no angles nor principalities nor power, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separated us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus or Lord.” Rom.8:37-39

As a mother knows without being told if one of her children is hurt; the child of God deals in a heighten spiritual awareness' in the Spirit world. Instinctively he is aware that more is happening in his spiritual temple then he has allowed himself to accept because false doctrine that he has been taught.

Once he accepts his God given assignment he will understand he is meant and purposed to deal with the sins others offered through the body. Thus, in this manner Christ brings all things causing death (*that, is causing separation from the Holy Spirit of God*) into captivity too God. That will be, restoration of what has been lost in Adam; is now being performed through his spiritual body

members. Christ Jesus brings every thought and lofty thing raised up against God into captivity. Thus, doing so by letting his spiritual body be led into fleshly law and slaughter daily by the law producing death. In turn Christ brings all fleshly thoughts into captivity.

“For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, Casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to obedience of Christ, And being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled 2Cor.10:3-6

“O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?” The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law.

But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.” 1Cor.15:55-58

“For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also abounds through Christ. Now if we are afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effective for enduring the same sufferings which we also suffer. Or if we are comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation.

And our hope for you is steadfast, because we know that as you are partakers of the sufferings, so also you will partake of the consolation.

For we do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, of our trouble which came to us in Asia: that were burdened beyond measure, above strength, so that we despaired even of life.

Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead, Who delivered us from so great of death and does deliver us: in whom we trust that He will still deliver us.

You also helping together in prayer for us, that thanks may be given by many persons on our behalf for the gift granted to us through many. 2Cor.1:4-11

“For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. For the earnest expectations of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.

For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now. Not only that, but we also who have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body.” Rom.8:18, 19, 22, 23

This brutal and painful death the child of God sometimes experiences daily is and often times greater than physical death. Many are slaughtered spiritually and often by their association with fleshly lovers of law, equally so by family members, children, and even their own mates.

Unseen by fleshly eyes and held in low esteem as foolish the workings of God moves forward silently in His Spiritual temple on earth and in heaven.

“Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. ‘For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, not jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.’” Matt.5:16-18

The child of God through the Great Spiritual Temple is translating the Law into the love through Christ Jesus, until death produce life through love. That is, every jot and tittle captive under one complex, but simple law of love.

This law of love in the Great Spiritual is God Himself – Jehovah the Almighty. There is no law against love or its fruitages; so eating thereof produce life.

The children of God must understand all laws of man produce death. Where some concluded the Law was dealt with some two thousand years ago it was not! Man cannot produce life from his best laws only death. All that has been woven upon all nations from the creation's beginning will be dealt with through the body of Christ.

Nothing hidden causing death to the human race will be left; all futility and corruptions will have been brought into captivity through Christ's body.

No human being on earth can state he has not broken the law. And all of us have condemned others for breaking the same law. Only those within Christ's body having been bought with the price of blood of Christ from the death of the law.

Thus, can make such a statement upon becoming a new creation in Christ Jesus. Yes, they have had the plank of law removed from their soul; pictured by the eye; not of their own will, but by the will of their Father. All members are, thus, equal in standing before God. They can no longer teach the law of death they administer the Spirit of life - the new covenant.

“Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.”
Matt.5:19

“Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; but he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force.” Matt.11:11, 12.

Thus, even John the Baptist broke the law and taught others the law.

The least in the kingdom of heaven is greater through the blood of Christ Jesus as a new creation, born in love, bought from the law, anointed by Spirit, brought into living Spiritual Temple of God.

Sheep For Slaughter Vs. Protection of Law

Thus, the child of God armed with this information will not let the fear in him that belongs to sin stand in his way of confessing them to His Heavenly Father. He will not let their fear become his fear. For it is not his fear, it is the fear of sin processed by the sinner. The child of God must conquer the fear through love of the Holy Spirit. Should he be slaughter by the sin of law God will glorify him by bring him up without condemnation. The child of God will be comforted and restore through Holy Spirit confirming he is dealing with the sins of others.

The very workings of God for the salvation of the world is the work to which we have been appointed for. The danger for the child of God is to deal with this sin according to doctrine of law.

The stronger he condemns through laws those he is assigned to minister the Spirit to; he condemns himself. However, when he deals with sin as his Father has dealt with him in love; he comes to understanding the depth and riches of God's love. His forgiveness and mercy in helping us and others.

The child of God then becomes like his head the Maters he is a sheep led to the slaughter, being put death all day long for the sins of others. When put death by sins of others he finds himself in a death state without God Holy Spirit. Sin has killed him he is brought like a sacrificially sheep under the law. Thus, the child of God has been crucified on torture stake.

God will rescue him miraculously bring him back to life through His Holy Spirit. This process continues as long as he walks in the flesh on earth. When his flesh dies he passed into heaven and his works in the spiritual temple goes right with him.

Sin Causing Death Vs. Sin Not Causing Death

Thus, the child of God knows the sin causing death and the sins that don't cause death. The sin causing death in the child of God is the law –praying for these sins are pointless the child of God is not under law they are in Christ Jesus. Thus, they are a live with Christ Jesus.

“And this is the testimony; that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of god, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God. 1John 5:11-13

This should give the child of God despite his many trials with the flesh under the law confidence not presumptuousness.

“Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.
1John 5:14, 15

Those loving law do not understand they are under death because of the law, thus, there interpretation of sin is sin. Flesh produces death, law produces death, doctrine produce death, sin produce death, and interpretation of law produces death. Man produces death!

“If anyone sees his brother sinning a sin which doesn't not lead to death, he will ask, and He will give life for those who commit sin not leading to death. There is sin leading to death. I do not say that he should pray about that.

A child of God is not making accusation against God's Holy ones, Never may that happen! No! When watching a brother under go tribulation within his flesh he must not assume it is the child of God's personal sins. That is, rather then the work he is assigned do within the Temple of God. If he judges that sin in a fleshly way according to the law he is guilty of accusations and administering death to his brother.

With God's Holy Spirit the child of God understands difference between personal sins and the sins of the laws death; for he abides in both of them at times. The sin of the law and death, he (the child of God) has been freed from and declared sinless through Christ Jesus fulfilling the law.

The sin not leading to death he can pray about owing to God's Holy Spirit in love. This sin will be dealt with through the head and God's Holy Spirit will heal. (that is, life will be given the weak or sick part of the body) The sin of the law cannot be healed through the Holy Spirit; the child of God no longer is under it so there is no point in praying about the sin of law.

Neither are sins a negative sense for the child of God as those under law of doctrine concludes. The doctrine of men live in death they glorify it naturally in fear. God the giver of life lives in love not fear and those who glorify life not death through law.

“All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin not leading to death. We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; (that is, according to law) but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch him.” 1John 5:17, 18

“But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, (that is, the Spirit of God) we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son Cleanses us from all sin. 1John 1:7

The child of God is cleansed from the sin causing death by the Law. That is, by being baptized into Christ. He is cleansed through the Holy Spirit of God through Christ Jesus for all other transgression which is sin. Thus, he is cleansed from all sin or both sins.

“If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.” 1John 1:8

If the truth is in us, that is, Christ Jesus, ‘I am the truth and the way’, the Holy Spirit convicts us of sin. We can not be in the truth and the Holy Spirit dwelling in us; if we say we have no sin!

“Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I don not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Of sin because they do not believe in Me; Of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.” John 16:7-11

The child of God is sinless according to the Law that Christ abolished through his blood. We are not sinless any other way we are still in a sinful body as well as a sinless body of Christ Jesus.

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.” 1John 1:9,10

In both cases sin does not attach to the child of God; provided the Word and Truth is in us (that is, Christ Jesus is in us); and the child of God openly confesses his transgression to God.

Any person stating they have not sin would have had to come from above; not from below - the earth. The whole human race has been subjected to corruption and futility by God. No doctrine of men that bring Christ Jesus under law can make you sinless - that one is a liar!

Confessing sin before fleshly men not those anointed with Holy Spirit might be a physiological fixes, but it is not a spiritual healing. In fact, the child of God must not be confused about this.

Upon, confessing his sins he now finds himself in greater spiritual problems. Moreover, let him not lose heart, for His Father in heaven always beholds his children. He has promised them He will make away out of all our trails; Christ wants to heal them through the Holy Spirit. We are a surly guarantee that in God’s do time all things will be made perfect and right.

Nor should a child of God be fearful; Christ gave us the assured promise that God comforter will always be with us and in us. Believing Christ words, that

is, putting faith in them despite fear guarantees God's favor once again and healing.

A child of God can not live under law, for if he lives according to the law he hates his brother. The law can not save his brother it can only put him to death. Thus, those promoting law over Christ; makes themselves a murderer. Loving doctrinal law over the freedom in Christ bring a person into darkness not light. The law allows a person to appear outwardly righteous (sinless) not bring the true nature of the person into the light of God's love through His Son Christ Jesus. It further makes men into hypocrites and liars.

That is, if you love law you hate your brother the law condemn your brother to death all the while thinking by your doctrine of law saves you!

“He who says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness until now. He who loves his brother abides in the light, and there is no cause for stumbling in him.” 1John 2:9, 10

This of course is a serious matter for God's children, walking in light; that is, being in the light is being in Christ Jesus, walking in darkness is being in the law.

Walking in the light in accepting Christ Jesus; walking in the law is denying Christ Jesus. The law blinds a person to Christ Jesus, that is. They may state his name and believe that he lived on earth and is in heaven, but deny the power of Christ by living under the law. The power of Christ set us free from the law that is sin and death.

“But he who hates his brother is in darkness and walks in darkness. And does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes.

I write to you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for His name's sake.” 1John.2:11, 12

Darkness passes away when a child of God is found in his anointing within the Christ. He is under the new commandment of love and he loves his brother so he not a murderer putting his brother to death through the law. No! He forgives as he is forgiven and gives his very life for his brother as a living sacrifice within

the body of Christ Jesus. He is fed as one body not many, he loves the other body part because “no man can hate his own body, but feeds and cherish it as Christ does his own body.”

Lovers of law are not satisfied with Christ and Christ alone, they always want more the flesh demands it, it is the nature of flesh. They bring Christ down off his exalted high throne in heaven stealing all freedoms from the child of God and binding the Christ with million upon million of rules of doctrines.

Living in fear of not being perfectly correct scripturally they search to find that one clue, that one piece of the puzzle that will lock Christ into giving them life. The worst thing for lovers of flesh is not having all the knowledge perfectly. Knowledge of rules, laws, and the scripture is their means of salvation. Sadly the more they search the greater the confusion and mystery becomes until the wear themselves out.

“Brethren, my heart’s desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.

For they being ignorant of God’s righteousness (Christ Jesus sent to them) and seeking to establish their own righteousness (that is, through the law), have not submitted to the righteousness of God.

For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. For Moses write about the righteousness which is to the law, “The man who does those things shall live by them.”

“But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, ‘Do not say in your heart. Who will ascend into heaven? (that is to bring Christ down from above) Or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’ (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

But what does it say? “The Word in near you, in your mouth and in your hearts”. (that is, the word of faith which we preach): Rom.10:1-9

Certainly the child of God cannot go back to the law if he returns to the law he again impale the Lord Christ Jesus. Will the law bring him up? Will the law go into death (that is, the abyss) and bring Christ his righteousness out of death? Will the law go into heaven and bring Christ Jesus down so we may understand the Holy Spirit that anointed us?

None of this is possible for the Law to perform; Christ being the end of the law allowed His Father Jehovah God out of love to bring his Son out of the abyss into heaven. Love without law brought Christ into our hearts through God's Holy Spirit. Thus, allows Christ Jesus into our mouths so we administer the Spirit through our hope (that is, Christ Jesus) to all who will listen.

All groups under the flesh boast of having the truth, the very fact they condemn and put down other faiths proves they don't have God's Spirit.

Christ did not come to condemn the world but to set it free from condemnation of fleshly law. He judged no one, but left judgment to His father. Under His Father's Holy Spirit, he shined light into darkness men's darkness hearts. (that is, not into the law physical) but spiritually into hearts.

The whole world has had their mouth shut at the giving of the law – all were found in death and wanting long before Christ came into this world in the flesh.

Children of God are now sprinkled among weeds, weeds of flesh appearing like wheat; weeds having no value in producing the fruits of life through God's Spirit. Many of the children of God are separated from other children of God, the weeds have taken over. So some children of God feel obligated to associate with weeds (Christian not anointed) walking in the flesh and under law.

There is no judgment against the children of God regards this matter, but let not the child of God be fooled they will always be in tribulation and persecution from fleshly weeds. And let the child of God be warned bad association spoils useful habits. Wherein, the child of God puts the doctrines of weeds above the love of God that dwells in him; he can impale Christ a new!
