

STOP JUDGING!

The book of Matthew

Chapter 7

Matt.7:1 "Don't judge, so that you won't be judged."

What possibly could Christ Jesus have meant in saying “don't judge, so that you won't be judged?” How is that possible in any endeavor of life where life itself demands that we judge in order to live? Moreover, the bible is full of God's own judgments against mankind; so how can God ask us to stop judging, and He Himself judges us, does that not make God a hypocrite?

Those that believe in this verse claiming they do not judge, make themselves a hypocrite in saying they don't judge others. Furthermore, they divide these verses into rules of doctrines; saying “ as long as I don't judge some one with my mouth I am safe”, but the bible teaches us God is not at all concerned with our mouth, but our hearts, in which our mouth speaks from, and we judge others with.

In all matters of life, from the day we are born until the day we die, we must judge to survive. Good parents teach their children how to judge matters of life, thus, giving them thinking ability equipping them for life. Subsequently, we have to judge spiritual matters so we are not misled; so factually we can say, it is humanly impossible for us not to judge.

By this statement we have spoken the truth, that is, the same truth God Himself spoke about sinful humankind when He stated:

***Jer.17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things, and it is exceedingly corrupt:
who can know it?***

17:10 I, Yahweh, search the mind, I try the heart, even to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his doings.

So if we are honest about our real condition as sinners we find ourselves condemned by Christ Jesus words found herein, making us fearfully wondering; how can anyone please God, and enter into the kingdom of God? Simply put, we all know the truth about ourselves that our mind and hearts judges all day long, condemning some while blessings others. We also know that it is a part of our sinful nature, and we just cannot stop judging, so we are forced to live a lie in being sweet to someone we don't like, while at the same time not being as nice to those we do like. But Jesus simply said; stop judging, so what exactly did he mean?

Matt.7:2 For with whatever judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with whatever measure you measure, it will be measured to you.

The words Jesus Christ spoke here are more than just words, they are truth(s) of our universe, why? Because Christ Jesus is Truth, he is also the Word of God, and Life, so whatever, he speaks is life. If we judge, we will be judged, and what we measure out too others will be measure out to us. So these are universal truth(s) that affect our eternal lives.

These powerful statements made by God's own Son, which he was teaching his disciples deep spiritual truths, a truths about life, not our physical life, but our spiritual lives. In other words, what does it take to live in life with God, that is, in His spiritual world, which means for a Christian, in the life of Christ Jesus? In that world life itself is sustain in goodness, and love, where all spiritual life adds too other spiritual life in symphonic harmony of life, light, and love. Wherein the measure of each spirit person adds to others, nothing is taken away, there is no taking, or reduction in the spiritual world, just giving which adds too life in abundance.

Matthew 19:21 Jesus said to him, "If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have, and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me."

Matthew 20:28 even as the Son of Man came not to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Luke 6:30 Give to everyone who asks you, and don't ask him who takes away your goods to give them back again.

Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" He who hears, let him say, "Come!" He who is thirsty, let him come. He who desires, let him take the water of life freely.

Here we find something so grand, and wonderful that human cannot live it, we can think about it, but our sinful nature refuses to let us live in such spiritual harmony. Our hearts long for better times, but we just cannot understand a life, or a world where we give good, and good comes back to us. We live in a world of judgment, judgments takes away from us, or steals what is good; giving us punishment instead of goodness. "Judgment", is the law of the world of the flesh, the flesh cannot survive without judgments; it is the universal law affecting the sinful flesh.

John 8:15 You judge according to the flesh. I judge no one.

Romans 7:5 For when we were in the flesh, the sinful passions which were through the law, worked in our members to bring forth fruit to death.

Romans 7:18 For I know that in me, that is, in my flesh, dwells no good thing. For desire is present with me, but I don't find it doing that which is good.

Romans 8:8 Those who are in the flesh can't please God.

But here Jesus is stating for those that would live with him in heaven the universal law of the spiritual world is love, which has no judgment, the law they would have to practice while in their flesh to overcome the world, becoming conquers in Christ Jesus.

Gal.5:17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, that you may not do the things that you desire.

5:18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

5:19 Now the works of the flesh are obvious, which are: adultery, sexual immorality, uncleanness, lustfulness,

5:20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, strife, jealousies, outbursts of anger, rivalries, divisions, heresies,

5:21 envyings, murders, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these; of which I forewarn you, even as I also forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith,{or, faithfulness}

5:23 gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Jesus did not tell his disciples to change this world by his love working through them, Jesus on the other hand, did tell his disciples to conquer this world in love, and he would change the world through his kingdom in what they learned in their sufferings according to the laws of love, the same law governing the spiritual world.

Here now is the context of Jesus words in Matthew Chapter Seven; he is not saying sinful people can stop judging, he is however, saying because we are sinful we cannot stop judging, and this is why we are dying. Moreover, this is why humans are in a constant state of pain, and suffering; not because we are good, but because we are evil and good and cannot be good all the time, which in turns causes us to judge others as good, or evil. These are the judgments that brings death too us; our judgments cannot bring us life as we would imagine. What we are doing is protecting this life now in our flesh, not our spiritual life, but Jesus lets us know we are not adding to our spiritual life in heaven with him, we are in fact doing is taking away from our spiritual lives now, and eternally.

1John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

1John 1:10 If we say that we haven't sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

So here Jesus opens the heavens to our eyes, the reality of what it takes for us to live in perfect spiritual life with our Father. This ideal is real, it exist in God's spiritual world right now; it is the way in which we were created to live, but we cannot because of our sin. Yes, sin passed on too us by Adam and Eve; lets us remember what tree they ate of, thus, bring the whole human race into sin, and death; it was the tree of “good and evil”. Yes, we have both in us, that is, good, and evil, but we are being told by Christ Jesus we must be done with the evil to live in life with him.

In others words, our judgments of others proves we have death, which is good and evil, but our flesh teaches us a lie, saying; judgments are good, or righteous, giving us life, and we will not survive with out our judgments in this world, in fact, it is something we should be proud of, because the better we are at judgments the more we receive in this life from flesh.

Now we might dismiss Christ Jesus words here, and say as the flesh does; we cannot stop judging so it is part of life, God will understand. But Jesus says “Stop Judging!” Then he does not make any excuses for us, he goes on in his teachings to show the bad effects of our judgments. So what Jesus is saying; this is your true condition, where are you going to go to get out of this evil circumstance, so you can stop judging? I have put life and death before you; if you chose judging you have chosen death. But if you chose life then you must stop judging.

Genesis 2:9 Out of the ground Yahweh God made every tree to grow that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the middle of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Genesis 3:22 Yahweh God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of us, knowing good and evil. Now, lest he put forth his hand, and also take of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever..."

Deuteronomy 30:15 Behold, I have set before you this day life and good, and death and evil;

Proverbs 14:27 The fear of Yahweh is a fountain of life, turning people from the snares of death.

John 4:14 but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never thirst again; but the water that I will give him will become in him a well of water springing up to eternal life."

John 1:4 In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

Matt.7:3 Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but don't consider the beam that is in your own eye?

Jesus speak to us a universal truth of the sinful flesh, if water is polluted with poison, and if we put it into fresh water both will become poisoned, and unfit to drink. How then can a person with death give another life, when all that is in them is death?

How can a person see clearly the thing causing another person death, when they also have death in themselves? So what is the point of removing a sin in another when my whole body is full of sin and death? What value is it then to be so angry with another sin? Thus, judging them with a righteous law when it only ends up in death for both of us? There is no point, it is death judging death. So then judging should at least have a good purpose in bring one up to a higher level, to a better person, should it not?

James 4:11 Don't speak against one another, brothers. He who speaks against a brother and judges his brother, speaks against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law, but a judge.

4:12 Only one is the lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge another?

James 3:10 Out of the same mouth comes forth blessing and cursing. My brothers, these things ought not to be so.

3:11 Does a spring send out from the same opening fresh and bitter water?

3:12 Can a fig tree, my brothers, yield olives, or a vine figs? Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh water.

But let us divert here but for a moment, and remember the former discussion of what it takes to live in a perfect spiritual world with God. Spiritual person don't judge to gain, they judge in love to give; adding to another spiritual life, love does not take away from one it adds life too others. The flesh judges only in death, and it judges to protect itself from being hurt in some way in a physical manner. So when one reads Jesus words physically at Matthew Charter Seven they can make no sense of it at all.

So now we have come to the crux's of the human problem, which is, we have both good and evil in us, however, by this can see evil in others because of the good and evil in us, thus, we feel we have the right to remove that which is evil in others; we gain nothing in our judgments of them, but death.

This now is Jesus meaning, if we are evil and good, judging another who are also good and evil, will simply measure out our own judgment, which is death. This is because we have both good and evil in us, so don't be fooled, we are in death, but in life there is only good, and no evil exist at all. And to prove this point just try to stop judging, and if you can, you will find life, but we cannot, so how can we find life?

Although some of our judgments are based on God's righteous laws they do not give us life, neither do they give the person we are judging life, so we find there is no point in our judging, and this is why Jesus said stop judging even with God's righteous laws. Although we may feel superior in judging with God's righteous laws, it does not make us superior because we are judging from a vessels of sin, and death. We may pour as much water as we please from our vessel, but all we have done is fill another with sin and death.

Luke 12:1 Meanwhile, when a multitude of many thousands had gathered together, so much so that they trampled on each other, he began to tell his disciples first of all, "Beware of the yeast of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.

1 Corinthians 5:7 Purge out the old yeast, that you may be a new lump, even as you are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, has been sacrificed in our place.

1 Corinthians 5:8 Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old yeast, neither with the yeast of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

Matt.7:4 Or how will you tell your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your eye;' and behold, the beam is in your own eye?

Jesus now says, even though we want to remove this sin from our brothers eye that is driving us crazy what we will find is a beam in our own eye. Yes, removing that speck of sin only leaves us with death, we have measured out death to ourselves; we have not measure out life, by our judgment; so stop judging, and we will not be judged.

John 5:24 "Most certainly I tell you, he who hears my word, and believes him who sent me, has eternal life, and doesn't come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

In other words; life is the only thing that produces life, we do not go to a dead body for life, we go to the living one for life. If we are dead in our sins, how can we rightly judge another into life, how can we give them life by our judgments?

John 8:51 Most certainly, I tell you, if a person keeps my word, he will never see death."

John 8:52 Then the Jews said to him, "Now we know that you have a demon. Abraham died, and the prophets; and you say, 'If a man keeps my word, he will never taste of death.'

But our sinful human hearts are full death dealing treachery, they says. "I see life in God's righteous laws, so if I judge my brother by them I have done good, and God should give me life. But Jesus says no! You will not get life by your judgments, even if you use my Fathers righteous laws. I know you do not believe me, but stop judging, and you will have life". In other words, Jesus says. "I can state my Father righteous laws only proves you are a sinner, but you refuse to believe me, so if you can stop judging you will have life".

Romans 5:12 Therefore, as sin entered into the world through one man, and death through sin; and so death passed to all men, because all sinned.

So now we have found the impossibility of not judging if we are honest of heart. Jesus states; "Now, perhaps you can believe that my Fathers righteous laws do not give you life unless you can stop judging; how then are you going to stop judging?" So here is the ultimate question of life and death, how can sinful people born under judgment from sin stop judging, so they can have life? All the judgments of the best of the human race has never brought peace or life, what they done is produce death, and past it on too us. All the books in the world full of man's wisdom has proven to be death.

***Rom.3:10 As it is written, "There is no one righteous; no, not one.
3:11 There is no one who understands. There is no one who seeks after God.
3:12 They have all turned aside.***

They have together become unprofitable. There is no one who does good, no, not, so much as one.{Psalms 14:1-3; 53:1-3; Ecclesiastes 7:20}

3:13 "Their throat is an open tomb. With their tongues they have used deceit."{Psalm 5:9} *"The poison of vipers is under their lips;"*{Psalm 140:3}

3:14 "Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness."{Psalm 10:7}

Rom.3:15 "Their feet are swift to shed blood.

3:16 Destruction and misery are in their ways.

3:17 The way of peace, they haven't known."{Isaiah 59:7-8}

3:18 "There is no fear of God before their eyes."{Psalm 36:1}

But if we could just stop judging then we would find life, if we could stop eating of the tree of good and evil then there would be life for us, so why should we make ourselves a hypocrite? Why do we hate our brother in our heart for his sin, and at the same time believe our judgments are life, when in fact, we have a beam of death in our own eye?

Matt.5:21 "You have heard that it was said to the ancient ones, 'You shall not murder;'{Exodus 20:13} *and 'Whoever shall murder shall be in danger of the judgment.'*

5:22 But I tell you, that everyone who is angry with his brother without a cause{NU omits "without a cause".} *shall be in danger of the judgment; and whoever shall say to his brother, 'Raca'*{"Raca" is an Aramaic insult, related to the word for "empty" and conveying the idea of empty-headedness.} *shall be in danger of the council; and whoever shall say, 'You fool!' shall be in danger of the fire of Gehenna.*{or, Hell}

Matt.7:5 You hypocrite! First remove the beam out of your own eye, and then you can see clearly to remove the speck out of your brother's eye.

However, Jesus tells us remove the beam from our own eyes, how indeed can a person remove the sin of death from themselves? Here now we have come upon the most important issue of the human race, how can we gain life, and stop judging? In other words, for us to stop judging we would have die, because in our flesh cannot stop judging, it is the universal law of the sinful flesh, we cannot stop judging, unless we make ourselves into a hypocrite, or die, what is a hypocrite? The word hypocrite comes from the theater of acting, in other word, to act like someone we are not.

To live a lie; putting on a face to look better than we actually are; of course this is acceptable to the sinful flesh because it is a way of life for with it, but not to God.

It is indeed much like looking at a tree and saying it is a bad tree because it produces bad fruit, but then we dress up the tree with beautiful lights to convince ourselves and other it has good fruit.

But when we eat from the tree we find it still has bad tasting fruit. Here we find the disappointment of all the wisdom of the human race. The fruits of which bring sickness, death. One comes too much disappointment in worshiping idols of men and woman. They are but trees of death, selling others a bag of goods regarding their great and wonderful life, but in reality their life may be dress up with many material things nevertheless they are death dealing fruits and not life; death produce nothing more than death; darkness does not reside in the light.

Jesus says "I am the light and life of the world. All those eating of me have life, I am the true vine." Nothing within Jesus Christ is death, he is life, and he himself has stop judging us, so only life existing in him, but wait a minute! God is a judge, he has judged people throughout the history mankind found in the bible. So the question is has God stop judging us?

Matthew 4:16 the people who sat in darkness saw a great light, to those who sat in the region and shadow of death, to them light has dawned. {Isaiah 9:1-2}

John 1:5 The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness hasn't overcome {The word translated "overcome" (katelaben) can also be translated "comprehended." It refers to getting a grip on an enemy to defeat him.} it.

John 8:12 Again, therefore, Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. {Isaiah 60:1} He who follows me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the light of life."

Here is another important question, is God a hypocrite by telling us to stop judging in His Son Christ Jesus, and than judging us? Does God have a double standard, or does He first stop judging us, and then ask us to stop judging others?

Proverbs 20:23 Yahweh detests differing weights, and dishonest scales are not pleasing.

God is not a hypocrite, God does not need to protect Himself from death, He is life; life immortal, and eternal life, and the source of all life. He gave His own Son Christ Jesus the same life in him. So God has stop judging humans which are a part of His Son Christ Jesus, but how, and why?

John 8:51 Most certainly, I tell you, if a person keeps my word, he will never see death."

Removing death by fulfilling the Law of death; if this statement is just too hard to believe, ask yourself, can you as a person stop judging? Then indeed you will know why God had to fulfill His righteous Law in Christ Jesus in removing His judgment against us; so we can come into life, that is, Christ Jesus God's life in us.

Romans 5:10 For if, while we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we will be saved by his life.

In other words, Christ Jesus fulfilled the Law of God that condemned us as sinners, so we have no more of God's judgments against us, now because there is no judgment of God and His Law; God has stop judging us, because where there is no judgment we find life; there can be only be life without judgments of the flesh. God has measured out good too us, while we were yet sinners, in death. God removed the beam of death from our eyes so we can walk in life.

Romans 5:17 For if by the trespass of the one, death reigned through the one; so much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign in life through the one, Jesus Christ.

Romans 5:21 that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

We have died to our sins under laws judgment, because the law was completed and fulfilled in Christ Jesus, thus, when we have become a part of Christ Jesus, we are dead to our judgments, Christ Jesus took our judgments so we can walk in life with him.

Romans 6:4 We were buried therefore with him through baptism to death, that just like Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life.

Now we eat from the good fruit tree of Jesus Christ, we eat only fruits of life, we no longer eat from the tree of good and evil; but instead the good fruits of Christ Jesus, so now we can stop judging, because there is no judgment against us in Christ Jesus, he is our life, and we have become part of his life, so we no longer have judgment against us.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus made me free from the law of sin and of death.

Here we find the unimaginable; we have not been removed judgment in our sinful flesh so we still judge, but because our judgment has been removed from us, that is, the judgment of God's righteous laws against us, we no longer judge or our judged. In other words, there is no judgment in Christ Jesus, Jesus took the judgment, completed it for us, Christ gave us his life, and that life lives through us although we are still in our sinful fleshly bodies.

Rom.8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who don't walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.{NU omits "who don't walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit"}
8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus made me free from the law of sin and of death.

In this way we stop judging, not because we can stop judging, but because Jesus give us his life where there is no judgment. We receive a gift so great that it is called grace, or undeserved kindness, from God's love. This gift of the life is the life of Jesus Christ, but it is more, it is also Christ Jesus own righteousness that covers us like a cloak of many colors, God sees Christ Jesus cloak instead of our judgments.

1Cor.1:30 But of him, you are in Christ Jesus, who was made to us wisdom from God, and righteousness and sanctification, and redemption:

Is this not a God of love, the same God that tells us to stop judging, and then gives us a gift so grand we can stop judging?

Here is the pearl of such great value, so unimaginable that it is beyond human understanding, God actually stops judging us in Jesus Christ. He now see us in life, and measure out only good too us, and we measure back good to Him, which producing greater life. Nothing so holy, and perfect should be given too dogs, nothing so beautiful can be known by death and sin. God must first show us love, and give us love, in order that we can understand life in the spiritual world.

Rom.8:37 No, in all these things, we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

8:38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, 8:39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

In the spirit world where we have now been born into by God's Holy Spirit, we find only good; good giving life, and light, where these unit into more life. Nothing is taken away in this life, life adds to love, love is adds to life, until immortal and incorruptible life exist. In this harmony God exist in pure good, and righteousness, in unimaginable beauty and where we exist in Jesus Christ.

James 1:16 Don't be deceived, my beloved brothers.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom can be no variation, nor turning shadow.

1:18 Of his own will he brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of first fruits of his creatures.

Matt.7:6 "Don't give that which is holy to the dogs, neither throw your pearls before the pigs, lest perhaps they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.

What can sinful flesh know but death, and what laws governs the sinful flesh, but death laws? Certain a pig does not care that a pearl is put into its pen, nor does a dog desires diamonds; they are what they are, what they have been created too be; so let us not change God's natural laws because we want a friends of the flesh. Let us not try to change someones nature; thinking we will gain from the flesh freedom and life in God's love.

James 3:12 Can a fig tree, my brothers, yield olives, or a vine figs? Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh water.

Here we must in all humility consider all the information above, and come to spiritual understanding that we did not give ourselves the life of Christ Jesus, who is the find pearl of great value. We did not make ourselves worthy enough to stop judging. We did not give ourselves the cloak of many colors of Christ Jesus own righteous, which removes our judgment of death.

We cannot honor ourselves in goodness for such a great and wonderful gift, nor can we understand all this without God's help through His Holy Spirit. Why should we throw such a unimaginable gift before those ruled by laws of the sinful flesh, who are unable understand?

Please don't be fooled just because a person has good and evil in them does not mean they can understand being born again. Not even Christ Jesus own Apostles understood it until the Holy Spirit was poured out upon them after Christ was killed by the dogs of law, and raised into the spirit world.

Yes, born again, not by mans will, but God's own will. Here we find the truth of Jesus Christ words, we have been born again, into God's family, and for this reason we can stop judging others according to God's righteous law. First of all God's judgments by the Old Law does not exist in us because we are born again into life, the life of Christ Jesus. Secondly, fleshly judgments of the law are of no value in the spirit world, they are value only to the sinful flesh.

The sinful flesh by its nature cannot stop judging because it is in death, but we can; thanks be to Christ Jesus! How can we then put death into life, and not get death? How can we think we can take the life of Christ Jesus, and give it to the flesh, and not get ripped a part by the laws of the flesh? How can we make flesh see anything, but what it naturally sees, and what it does, which is laws, and judgments. How can we ask the flesh not to judge us when that is what it created to do with God's laws? How can we empty the vessel of Christ Jesus waters of life into the flesh pen of pigs?

Philippians 3:2 Beware of the dogs, beware of the evil workers, beware of the false circumcision.

Revelation 22:15 Outside are the dogs, the sorcerers, the sexually immoral, the murderers, the idolaters, and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.

How can we make a person of the flesh stop judging? Here we find what Christ Jesus is speaking of; the flesh is under law, it legislates law, it pounds law into law breakers to make them stop doing what offends the flesh. The law of the spirit is love, it does not legislate law; law takes away from life, but life give more life by removing judgment of the law.

What we received in Jesus Christ is a divine gift given in God's love too us; God searched our hearts, and made divine appointments so we would be taught by others of the spirit world, none of which the flesh had any thing to do with. All in Christ Jesus is spirit lead, truth feed, and faith driven, which is life giving. If we cannot expect life to come from death, that is, the teachings of the flesh established upon God's righteous laws found in a church, using these is like throwing our gift of life by heavens of Jesus Christ to the pigs of the flesh.

Isaiah 33:6 There will be stability in your times, abundance of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge. The fear of Yahweh is your treasure.

Ezekiel 22:25 There is a conspiracy of her prophets in its midst, like a roaring lion ravaging the prey: they have devoured souls; they take treasure and precious things; they have made her widows many in its midst.

Matthew 6:21 for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Matthew 13:44 "Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure hidden in the field, which a man found, and hid. In his joy, he goes and sells all that he has, and buys that field.

This would be the same as putting pearls into a pig pen, and expecting them too appreciated the law of the spirit in love, no indeed! We will find only trampling, and disrespect for our precious, and fine pearl, and then our being ripped a part by dogs governed by the flesh, which are the judgments of laws of death.

These will do so with a scared violent zeal for law destroying anything righteous and good found in our Lord and Savior Jesus.

They eat from death tree of good, and evil, bring more death. This testimony rings throughout the history of human race into the our ears. We as God's children must eat from the good tree of life, Jesus Christ, turning away from and giving over our judgments of good and evil to the one who judges righteously, Jehovah God through His Son Christ Jesus.

Revelation 5:4 And I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open the book, or to look in it.

Revelation 5:9 They sang a new song, saying, "You are worthy to take the book, and to open its seals: for you were killed, and bought us for God with your blood, out of every tribe, language, people, and nation.

Matt.7:7 "Ask, and it will be given you. Seek, and you will find. Knock, and it will be opened for you.

Let us not put our fine pearl of Jesus Christ before those loving death by laws of the flesh, lets believe in faith the words of Jesus Christ our faith, in saying' “ knock and you will receive, ask and you will find”.

We serve a loving God who we call Father, how could he be love if He did not open too us in compassion? But He has opened, and removes our judgments in His love, and He give us faith.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, then I will come in to him, and will dine with him, and he with me.

2Cor.5:18 But all things are of God, who reconciled us to himself through Jesus Christ, and gave to us the ministry of reconciliation;

5:19 namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself, not reckoning to them their trespasses, and having committed to us the word of reconciliation.

5:20 We are therefore ambassadors on behalf of Christ, as though God were entreating by us: we beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

5:21 For him who knew no sin he made to be sin on our behalf; so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

What we are required to do is walk in faith like the wind and believe only good comes from our Father, we are to stop judging God in His goodness for us, we are stop taking His position as though we have so much more concerned for the world salvation, so we legislate laws of the flesh to make others preach, unwittingly preaching death, instead of acknowledging the truth in how we ourselves received life. But should we return to legislating rules, and knocking on physical doors instead of walking by faith we have measured out death to ourselves and other, and will receive death back. Life comes from life, Jesus Christ is Life, he listens, and comes to the spiritual door of hearts; those seeking God, he enters if they open, he does not brain wash by laws of the flesh, that is, repeating words over, and over again until the person acknowledges God as being right, by some religious doctrine.

Matthew 13:13 Therefore I speak to them in parables, because seeing they don't see, and hearing, they don't hear, neither do they understand.

Matthew 13:34 Jesus spoke all these things in parables to the multitudes; and without a parable, he didn't speak to them, Matthew 13:35 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken through the prophet, saying, "I will open my mouth in parables; I will utter things hidden from the foundation of the world." {Psalm 78:2}

He does not pound doctrine into the heart so the person will accept a certain group of people as God's people, he leads in love, peacefully, quietly, and with deep respect for God's love, in that, God has given each of us a free will to chose good and evil. Christ Jesus knows His Father will not forget a single person on earth, he knows all hope for the human race does not exist in laws of death governing the flesh, but in love, God's is love, for the world.

John 6:63 It is the spirit who gives life. The flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and are life.

John 8:15 You judge according to the flesh. I judge no one.

It is this writers best hope you come to know the undeserved kindness of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Coming to rest in God's love for us, when we rest in him we find the truth of God's love flowing into our heart.
